### PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SUMMARY OF ROLE

The Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) Activity is a U.S. Department of State-funded initiative implemented in South Sudan by IntraHealth International to strengthen HIV prevention, care, and treatment services. The project approach focusses on Facility and community led responses, strategic case finding, retention in care, and the delivery of high quality, client centered HIV services.

The ART Provider is responsible for improving the quality of HIV care and treatment services at supported health facilities. The role ensures that clinical services adhere to Ministry of Health and PEPFAR technical standards and supports comprehensive HIV care, treatment monitoring, retention, and facility-community linkages.

Key Functional Focus Areas:

- Clinical management of HIV and TB cases
- ART service delivery and patient monitoring
- Early infant diagnosis and pediatric HIV care
- Adherence, retention, and cohort monitoring
- Clinical mentorship and continuous medical education
- Facility-community linkages for PLHIV support

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES / ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

#### Clinical Care & Treatment

- Provide full-time clinical evaluation and treatment services to people living with HIV in outpatient and inpatient settings.
- Provide clinical consultation for management of HIV and TB cases within the facility and catchment areas.
- Ensure quality chronic HIV care and treatment services in line with national and donor guidelines.



### **Pediatric HIV & PMTCT Support**

- Provide clinical follow-up for HIV-exposed infants and their caregivers.
- Support Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) services and management of HIV-infected children.

### **ART Monitoring & Retention**

- Monitor ART patients and discuss treatment failures with the ART team to determine appropriate interventions.
- Participate in cohort analysis and treatment outcome reviews.
- Establish and maintain systems for documentation and reporting of adherence and retention interventions.

### **Capacity Building & Team Support**

- Provide continuous medical education (CME) to multidisciplinary facility teams on scheduled clinical topics.
- Work with HTC providers to ensure accurate identification and linkage of HIV-positive clients to care and treatment.

### **Community Linkages & Quality Improvement**

- Work with facility-based peer adherence supporters and PLHIV associations to strengthen facility–community linkages.
- Continuously improve the quality of HIV clinical care and treatment services.

### **Required Qualifications**

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine or a related field.
- Minimum of three (3) years of experience providing HIV/AIDS clinical services.
