Purpose of the position:

The Protection and MHPSS Officer will enhance protection and MHPSS systems across school-based systems. The program aims to improve safety in schools through safety assessments and school improvements. The cases of child abuse including corporal punishment and SRGBV will be reduced across schools in all the MYRP target schools. School protection systems are still weak and reporting mechanisms need strengthening through continued investment in capacity building, reporting and referral mechanisms. MHPSS training and capacity building among teachers: Sustainable approaches through mainstreaming MHPSS and Social Emotional Learning (SEL) within the education system would enhance ownership and services to learners.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Execution of protection and MHPSS components through establishment and strengthening of multi-sectoral referral pathways, including with protection, GBV, and health actors, to prevent and respond to protection, health and MHPSS risks and incidents in Tonj North, Warrap State.
- Undertakes regular protection service delivery for vulnerable women, girls and children to recover from the traumatized experience caused by conflict and forced displacements. Conduct community awareness campaigns on prevention of child and GBV.
- Support tailored MHPSS and life skills training and services for young mothers in schools. Conduct school based MHPSS, GBV, CP and risk mitigation assessments and Support co-curriculum activities in schools as part of mental health and well-being.
- Provide supplies and technical support to teachers to deliver HEART, Team-Up and Socio-emotional learning (SEL) and Facilitate GBV committees to develop and implement GBV risk mitigation plans.
- Support and mentor CFS Animators/Facilitators and ensure weekly, monthly, quarterly reports etc are produced and shared with Project Coordinator/Manager.
- Perform other relevant tasks as assigned by line manager,



Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience.

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training: **Minimum Qualification required:**

- Bachelor's degree in related field, particularly social work, psychology, International Development or Gender Studies
- Minimum of 2 years prior work experience, including MHPSS, GBV and Child Protection program design and management with at least one-year experience with International, humanitarian Agency.
- Demonstrated application of CP, GBV, MHPSS core competencies and commitment to core principles of protection programming.
- Strong knowledge of standards and guidelines for GBV, MHPSS and CP programming, coordination, and data management.
- Experience with MHPSS, GBV and CP case management services
- Facilitation experience required
- Supervisory experience required
- Experience working with partners and community mobilization preferred
- Profound cross-cultural awareness
- Ability to exercise sound judgment, remain flexible, and apply experience and guidance to evolving challenges
- Strong communication skills, both oral and written.
