Organizational background

Major Responsibilities:

He/She will ensure the successful operation of the health and nutrition project activities in Pigi canal, Fanagak, Nyirol and Ayod Counties of Jonglei State. The Roving Health and Nutrition Supervisor will provide technical capacity, and overall leadership for the County teams and assist in the strategic planning and decision for the teams in strengthening integrated health and nutrition activities in all the counties. He/she will be responsible for overall monitoring and evaluation, reporting data and expenditures to the Project Manager.

The Health and Nutrition Supervisor will be tasked with the following responsibilities: -

- Provide management support to the clinical and non-clinical staff and ensure MoH standard protocols and procedures in the implementation of health, nutrition, and community activities in the project sites



- Provide technical capacity to ensure all health and nutrition activities are implemented in accordance with South Sudan CMAM guidelines, MoH guidelines, and cluster guidelines.
- Support procurement team to ensure all health and nutrition supplies are procured in time, ensure a clear referral pathway is obtained with other partners.
- Promote integration of programme activities at a community-level, placing programme beneficiaries at the heart of IMA World Health programs.
- Conduct routine supportive supervision visits to health facilities, nutrition sites and mobile outreach sites to provide supervision, technical oversight, and mentoring.
- Work closely to develop staff capacity career development by conducting mentorship and conduct routine trainings.
- Provide needs-based training for IMA World Health staff and partners on health and nutrition tools that will enable the teams to work effectively.
- Should have proper knowledge on integrated health and nutrition activities in an emergency setting.

Qualifications/Experience/Skills

- Bachelor's degree in Medicine/Nursing/Public health or any other relevant qualification with 5 years of health and nutrition programming
- A background in management of emergency health and nutrition response
- Computer literacy
- Ability to provide mentorship, training and supportive supervision
