Responsibilities of the Food Security and Livelihoods officer include but are not limited to:

# **Program Management**

- The FSL Officer will be responsible for direct field implementation of livelihood component of the RSRTF include monitoring and support VSLA and IGA groups member's activities.
- S/he will plan, implement and monitor project activities related to resilience
- Ensure community mobilization, beneficiary's selection, inputs distribution, and farmers' training.
- Enhance Women 's Income generation, diversification and empowerment through provision of small business grants, start-up support for viable income generating activities.
- Form or strengthen Village Saving and Loan Association to Promote community based savings and financial services.
- Facilitate VSLA members to identify relevant community assets and support them with cash for work to repair/renovate
- Train VSLA groups on the VSLA approaches, methodologies and support VSLA members to independently manage their savings and loan processes.
- Provide underground safe vaults for VSLAs.
- People Management/ Promote gender equity and diversity by encouraging a gender responsive work environment and conducting gender equitable FSL VSLA groups formation
- Providing capacity building, feedback, coaching to the Village Saving and Loan Associations groups on business and income generating activities. Work closely with Line
- Managing Staff performance and support them with skills for building sustainable Livelihoods in Koch.
- He/She shall be abided by humanitarian principles when dealing with beneficiary, respect to CARE policy on PSEA and code of conduct.

## Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability and Learning (MEAL)

- Working with appropriate staff and partners to implement, evaluate and report on the RSRTF project activities, principally at field/community level
- Conduct regular field visits to monitor and provide feedback on the effectiveness of the interventions
- Ensure that the project implementation is based on participatory needs limit beneficiary expectations.
- Ensure that detailed monthly work plans and reports are submitted timely
- Other responsibilities as needed.
