Purpose of the position:

This *Purpose of this Position* is to coordinate the activities of BMZ project in NBeG and he/she is Responsible for planning, design, implementation and providing oversight of technical DRR and WASH project technical designs, measurements, interventions including group mobilization, training, and monitoring of technical activities in the field locations. Key to this position is Water facilities and water resources development covering areas of hydraulics, structural design, fluid mechanics drainage engineering and hydrological flow analysis, Boreholes drilling, development, rehabilitations and sizing of pumps and solar related infrastructure.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Carry out Engineering planning & surveying using relevant survey equipment, produce CAD design and generate precise Bill of quantities for all Civil & Water engineering works. Provide Coordination's of technical activities within the project locations, among different stakeholders like local authorities, RRC commission, executive chiefs and selected beneficiaries.
- 2-Select and Implement viable and technically sound engineering approaches and practices including water Yard upgrading to solar pumping mechanisms, size the pumps, solar panels, inverters, control panels and related electrical appliances associated with boreholes drilling, equipping and rehabilitation.
- 3-Documentation of all infrastructure activities and files under the selected Bomas.
- 4-Reporting of weekly and monthly activities about technical specifications on the implementation and other reports required by WV
- 5-Training the selected beneficiaries on constructed infrastructures.
- Perform any other tasks as assigned my supervisor.

Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training: **Minimum Qualification required:**

- Prospective candidates should have a minimum of diploma or degree in Civil Engineering/Water and Environmental Engineering/Mechanical Engineering or Architecture
- Must have proven experience in structural design & CAD drafting of all construction infrastructure
- Must be experienced in Water works (Shallow wells, borehole drilling, development, equipping) and design of water reticulation systems-Water pipeline, distribution tanks, water kiosks and stand points.
- Must be conversant with Photovoltaics planning, design and element selection (solarization of boreholes and water yards)
- Must be a committed Christian, able to stand above denominational diversities
- This position requires a mature candidate, a self-starter, with dedication and ability to work with less or no supervision. Must demonstrate willingness to learn and work with others as a team.
- Candidates should also have at least 4 years of previous experience in a related field.
