Background

Since 2011, we have been at the forefront of delivering life-changing humanitarian and development programs in Food security and Livelihoods, education, protection, gender equality, Health, Nutrition, WASH, and peace building for returnees, IDPs, and host communities.

As a key implementing partner under the FAO funded GRACE project in Juba County to strengthen food security, climate resilience, and sustainable livelihoods. To support our expanding portfolio and strategic growth, we are recruiting a highly motivated and qualified **Agronomist**

Job Purpose

The Agronomist officer will oversee planning, coordination, and monitoring of activities under the GRACE Project ensuring effective implementation, stakeholders collaboration, and compliance technical and financial requirements and results reporting.

Key Responsibilities

- Identify, form, and provide technical support to producer groups and farmer groups.
- Train farmer groups on crop production using appropriate agronomic approaches and climate-smart methodologies.
- Support producer groups to develop community assets (e.g., flood dyke protection, multipurpose water infrastructure, drainage channels) through Labour-Intensive Public Works (LIPW).
- Train groups in disaster management, sustainable land restoration, and water conservation practices in drought- and flood-prone areas.
- Conduct training on value chain processes such as post-harvest handling, processing, packaging, safety, and standards (especially for vegetables).
- Train selected women and youth in leadership and decision-making.
- Facilitate the adoption and training of farmers on green technologies (e.g., solar-powered irrigation systems).
- Conduct assessments on familiarity, suitability, and cultural acceptance of green technologies.





Support the construction and promotion of Improved Cooking Stoves (ICS) and Fuel-Efficient Stoves (FES).

Identify and train local artisans to fabricate, sell, and service farming tools and equipment.

Mobilize and raise awareness among community members on environmental issues.

Qualifications & Experience

Education:

Bachelor's degree in Agronomy, Crop Science, Agricultural Extension, or related field (Master's degree is an added advantage).

A relevant Higher Diploma will also be accepted with a minimum of 4 years' proven

experience.

Experience:

At least 3 years of experience (or 4 years with a higher diploma) in agronomy, extension services, or livelihoods/agriculture projects.

Experience working within Juba County and strong knowledge of its geography, farming

systems, and communities is essential.

Technical expertise in climate-smart agriculture, soil fertility, land and water management, and post-harvest handling.

Familiarity with green technologies such as solar irrigation and ICS/FES stoves.

Strong facilitation, training, and reporting skills.

Fluency in English; knowledge of Arabic or local languages is an asset.
