

JOB VACANCY: Program Assistant (1 position)

The organisation is now seeking to recruit suitable qualified **South Sudanese nationals** for the positions of **Program Assistant.**

Duty Station: Isohe, Ikwoto County, Eastern Equatorial State, South Sudan;

Department: Education (Distance Support Program).

Starting Date: Successful candidate should be ready to start work within 1 week from the date of

confirmation of employment.

Aim of the Position: The Program Assistant will track education activities of Distance Support Program in schools and communities in Ikwoto, Torit and Magwi Counties.

Specific Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Review compiled forms and reports by social workers about the children for both internal use and external circulation.
- Support in regular monitoring and supervision of activities of social workers and community mobilizers/education promotors in schools.
- Support social workers and community mobilizers/education promotors in Carrying out regular followup in villages/children's homes of non-reporting pupils enrolled in the programme and/or of any specific issue/case regarding children under support.
- Liaise with the social workers and community mobilizers/ education promotors to follow-up individual cases referred for assistance.
- Support the program Manager in recommendation and development of ideal interventions to address needs of vulnerable families.
- Support in planning and implementation of activities that promote community involvement in education, regular attendance and participation of children at school with special attention to girls.
- Liaise with the school management and county education department to carry out fitting extra curricula activities for pupils (home economics trainings; hygiene sessions, debates, games and sports, etc.).
- Support in Planning and organizing of distributions of items for the selected children under the AVSI DSP scholarships program.
- To act as liaison between the social workers, community mobilizers/education promotors, and the child through DSP local office and HQs, ensuring and maintaining regularly and effective correspondence with sponsors.
- Build and maintain links with Headmasters and teachers of the selected schools and other local partners
 that emerge during the course of activities.

- Knowledge of the local language (Lotuko) and South Sudanese Arabic is required.
- Knowledge of the National Education system.
- Aware of the Education system of the country and national Education problems\challenges.
- Understanding of the main development problems in the poorest area of the country.
