Job Title: Registered Nurses (3 positions)
Reporting to: Clinical Officer
Location: Kodok & Manyo
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The registered nurse is expected to contribute to the broader outcomes of the emergency health team by ensuring that all patients visiting mobile clinics are treated and provided care in accordance with South Sudanese & International protocols and guidelines. S/he is responsible for the medical treatment of those patients and preventing further deterioration, through the provision of therapeutic feeds, routine and specialised medicine, health and nutrition counselling. The registered nurse is also responsible for ensuring quality of services through capacity building and technical support in the mobile clinic team.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

Programme Management and Technical Supervision

Carry out systematic medical screening and treatment of all children and adult admitted treated at mobile team sites by ensuring that comprehensive medical examinations are conducted, vital signs checked, and frequent treatment is provided as per protocols.

- Adhere to current protocols on drug administration, including, but not limited to, antimalarial, antibiotics, and anthelmintic medications.

Ensure caretakers and beneficiaries seeking services are treated with respect at all times and messages are communicated to them clearly by health staff.

- Ensure that caretakers correctly understand their child's nutritional and health status and offer advice on how they can care for their child to improve his/ her health status.

- Record all medical and nutrition orders in the patient file and register as per guidelines.

Other

Be aware of, understand and comply with all of WVSS's policies and procedures (P4, finance, logistics, HR, security management etc).

- Contribute to ongoing security management and planning as necessary.

- Actively participate in any emergency response if called upon to do so (within the existing programme area or in a new one).

- Undertake other related duties as may reasonably be assigned by the Country Director or the line manager

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Degree/Diploma/Certificate in Nursing
- Experience working in an NGO in relation to health or nutrition
- Previous experiences in running mobile clinic activities
- training such as IMNCI, CMR, PMTCT, HIV/AIDS
- Registration with nursing councils of South Sudan
- Energetic and self-motivated, with skills in community mobilization, training, and team-building;
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision;
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines
- Be a committed Christian who espouses Christian values throughout his/her work
- South Sudanese Nationals only
