INTRODUCTION:

ACROSS in South Sudan is looking for competent and qualified South Sudanese national fill the position of EPI Nurse.

Main Job Purpose:

Under the supervision of the Health Officer and the support of the clinical officer, the EPI Nurse will support deliver of quality immunization services in Gorom PHCC. S/he will ensure correct vaccines administration to intended beneficiaries, adequate supply of vaccines, proper management of the cold chain, Plan outreach activities and sensitization to ensure proper coverage and service utilization.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Supervises EPI Vaccinators at all Health facility.
- Collect and compile monthly, quarterly reports and submitted to Health Officer.
- Do monthly/weekly immunization Schedule and outreach activities.
- Carry out training activities/facilitation to vaccinators and social mobilizers.
- Linking on information dissemination and giving feedback from the field on trainings progress/needs to the Health Officer.
- Carrying out community awareness campaign/sessions on vaccine preventable diseases.
- Participate in NIDs (National Immunization Days) monitoring and supply vaccine.



- Establish good relationship between the community leaders and the organization
- Ensure that the Vaccine is distributed to the health facility point regularly.
- Ensure the proper maintaining/monitoring of cold chain by checking the temperature twice a day
- Forecasting, storage, recording and monitoring of vaccines
- Safely provide immunizations to infants, children and adults, in accordance with MoH guidelines, including:
 - a. Static vaccination sessions in basic health units
 - b. Outreach activities in the field
 - c. Mass vaccination campaigns
- Record and share relevant, up to date information in a timely manner including:
 - **a.** Maintaining accurate records to monitor coverage of target population
 - b. Maintain accurate EPI records
 - c. Recording and reporting measles cases
 - d. Regularly contributing to clinic reports as required
- Provides health education to waiting patients and surrounding community to support.
- Asses, plan, direct and evaluate nursing care as determined by the patients age and cultural needs in accordance with established standards, policies and procedures of BPHS MoH SS
- Give comprehensive nursing care in the IPD and OPD (dressing and treatment room)
- Screening patients at the triage area and organize good patient flow according to first come first seen basis
- Provide comprehensive Nursing care to patients such as timely administration of both oral and injectable medications, basic nursing procedure, monitoring patients vital signs
- Observe and maintain patient confidentiality at all the time as well protection of data and information

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

 Bachelor degree, Diploma or Certificate in Nursing from a certified institution, with valid license certificate.
