JOB TITLE: PMTCT Midwife (8)

LOCATION: Mapourdit Hospital, Yei state hospital, Juba Teaching hospital, Kiir Mayardit Maternity hospital, Maridi state hospital, Rumbek state hospital, Wau Teaching hospital, Yirol state hospital.

DIRECT REPORT: Facility HIV Care and treatment Unit.

ICAP IN SOUTH SUDAN

The overall ICAP project goal is to support the South Sudan Ministry of Health to rapidly expand HIV/AIDS prevention, care and treatment activities and reduce HIV/AIDS related morbidity and mortality in South Sudan, by providing technical support for the country's HIV/AIDS prevention, care and treatment initiatives.

OVERALL JOB FUNCTION:

The objective of this position is to strengthen coordination, ownership and improve quality of PMTCT service delivery in facility of assignment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coordinate the overall PMTCT services within the facility.
- Oversee/ensure HIV testing of all pregnant, breastfeeding women, their infants and male partners.
- Ensure linkage of all HIV positive pregnant, breastfeeding women, their HIV exposed/infected infants and male partners to treatment services.
- Provide full time clinical evaluation and treatment services to HIV positive patients and their families in the facility.
- Provide clinical follow up of HIV Exposed infants (HEI) and their parents, facilitates early infant diagnosis services and proper management of HIV infected children.
- Ensure all HEIs have got early infant diagnosis services and viral load monitoring for all on anti-retroviral treatment (ART).
- Mentor and participate in training for other health care workers.
- Provide regular continuing medical education to the multidisciplinary team.
- Coordinate the MDT to conduct periodic review of quality of services and implement improvement plans through:
 - Monitoring progress to set performance targets
 - Standard of care (SOC) analysis
 - Cohort analysis and Cascade analysis

- Perform any other duties as may be assigned.

EDUCATION:

- Midwife or Clinical Officer
- Training and clinical experience in HIV/AIDS care and antiretroviral treatment is preferable.

Qualifications:

- Ability to work independently with strong problem-solving skills including the ability to foresee problems and initiate appropriate action.
 - Computer literacy in Microsoft applications and other software.
 - Flexible, excellent interpersonal and team building skills and ready to learn from others.
 - Fluency in written and spoken English and one or two local languages in South Sudan
- This position is for South Sudanese nationals only.**
