BACKGROUND

The International Rescue Committee (IRC) responds to the world’s worst humanitarian crises and helps people to survive and rebuild their lives. IRC continues to provide life-saving assistance and humanitarian aid to vulnerable South Sudanese, trying to rebuild their lives and restore peace. The IRC’s new strategy in South Sudan will prioritize improving health, safety, and economic well-being, targeting women, children, and other vulnerable.

JOB OVERVIEW

The Clinical Officer will work to ensure improved quality of Primary Health care services at Sector in Don Bosco IDP camp including comprehensive and reproductive health services, outpatient, Inpatient, MHPSS, PMTCT, EPI, and established community outreach services and nutrition well-being of population. The clinical officer will work directly with WPE/Health manager to ensure quality delivery of Health services.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Implement medical services provision both curative and preventive in Sector in Don Bosco IDP camp according to the relevant South Sudan adopted Ministry of Health guidelines for the management of patients.
- Actively triage patients on admission based on their conditions and design a management plan.
- Refer more complicated cases to Hospital work clear detailed referral note for advanced management.





- Clinical review of the patients during the morning and evening ward rounds either independently or with the support of the medical doctors and other senior staff involved in the management of patients.
- Analyze training needs and institute trainings for staff members as required, with an emphasis on hands on training
- Collaborate with recognized health authorities, health agencies, and other stakeholders in the joint management of patients.
- Work with logistic team to ensure regular and adequate drug and medical supplies in order to avoid stock outs especially PPEs and other cleaning supplies.
- Utilize standardized data collection tools and train staff on accurate data collection
- Participate in professional medication education to the staff in new advances in patient management and other refresher courses deemed necessary.
- Supervise and ensure that all the infection prevention procedures are followed according to the standards as per WHO/MOH Guidelines.

Health information system

- Support in compiling weekly IDSR reports, Monthly HMIS and monthly drugs inventory reports and share with M&E Officer of entry in DHIS2
- Assist in providing data and other information required for donor, cluster partners and organization reporting.

Clinical Protocols

- Ensure the implementation of the infection prevention and control in coordination and supervision with Health manager
- Provide technical support to the health team in each department to ensure daily supervision and monitor the implementation of infection control activities
- Ensure that Treatment Guideline are implemented and followed by all staff (CO, Nurses, Midwives, Lab technician and Community Health Workers)

Pharmaceutical Management

- Support the pharmaceutical management system for the Health Facility including drugs requisition from the main store, drugs utilization and consumption reporting from each department.
- Support in compiling monthly drugs consumption reports and share with relevant managers.
- Provide clinical support to the teams and clinician. Monitors prescriptions and conducts audits to ensure legitimacy and clinically justified based on WHO/MoH protocols

Staff management and capacity building

- Conduct regular meetings with clinical officers, nurses, and community health workers.
- Participate in weekly, monthly, and quarterly management meetings
- Participate in program development and setting priorities for the Sector 5 Health facility.
- Participate in organizing continuous medical education

- Diploma or a degree in clinical medicine from a reputable institute.
- Registered as a Clinical Officer in South Sudan and licensed to practice.
- Computer literate with proficiency in Microsoft office programs, medical databases.
