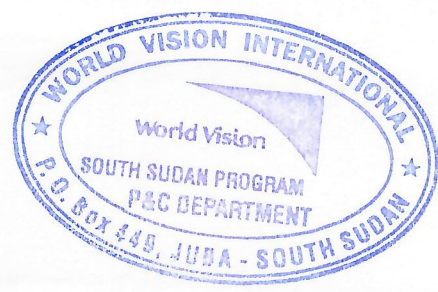
Job title: Mine Awareness Assistant
Reporting to: Mine Awareness Officer
Location: Juba
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

Mines and UXOs pose a serious threat to safety and may cause injury to communities, especially children who may mistake these as objects for play and not recognize the danger. Mine Risk Education is designed to help adults and children learn to the dangers of mines/UXOs, how to recognize, report and mitigate mine risks at community level. The Mine Risk Assistant is primarily responsible for delivering engaging and interactive education sessions on mine risks, identification of ordnances, risk mitigation and community-based reporting.

Key Job responsibilities

- Conduct mine risk education sessions using gender-sensitive and age-appropriate strategies, including child-friendly sessions
- Complete daily / weekly reporting to Mine Risk awareness officer
- Follow up with victims and communities involving community members and complete the necessary IMSMA reports as required, as well as provision of first aid services.
- Establishes and maintains effective communication between the team and the local community.



Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- At least a Diploma in Social work, International Relations, and Social Sciences.
- At least Accredited Certificate in Mine Risk Training with Secondary school certificate preferred.
- Strong experience in conducting Mine Risk Education is **STRONGLY** preferred.
- Strong experience and knowledge in conducting Mine Risk Education
- Strong knowledge on giving first aid
- Must have a love for children and demonstrate patience, tolerance, problem solving, open-mindedness and interest in social justice.
- Basic written / speaking English strongly preferred
- Local language as first language strongly preferred

Working Environment / Conditions:

- Work environment: County level; 70% working from CFS site and/or Child Help Desk location
- Competitive benefits, including health insurance
