Organizational Background

Universal Intervention and Development Organization (UNIDOR) is a South Sudanese national and Faith based Organization founded in 2004 and is legally registered by the Relief and Rehabilitation commission (RRC) with registration number 181. UNIDOR is a member of South Sudan NGOs forum, active member of different working clusters across the Country. UNIDOR operates in 4 states and over 11 counties in South Sudan with program portfolio covering health, nutrition, FSL, WASH, Education, General protection including GBV and Child Protection, Peace-Building and Conflict Resolution. UNIDOR continues to provide lifesaving humanitarian assistance to the vulnerable people of South Sudan with the aim of rebuilding lives and restore peace.

UNIDOR seeks application from qualified South Sudanese National to fill in the position of Nutrition Officer to be based in Rubkona, Unity State.

Job Description

The Nutrition Officer will work directly under the responsibility of Nutrition Roving Officer and the Nutrition Manager in Coordinating and Implementing Nutrition Project scaling up prevention of malnutrition, reduce the morbidity and mortality of vulnerable population with keen focus to children under 5 years, pregnant and lactating women in Rubkona county, Unity state through provision of integrated nutrition services.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Co-ordinate and monitor Nutrition Intervention in close collaboration with CHD, SMOH, partners, CSO and CBOs in line with the national CMAM/MIYCN guidelines, and program objectives.



- Strengthen linkage between all the component of CMAM per the guideline and appropriate referrals between other programs in the community with synergies between nutrition and other sectors like health, wash, FSL... etc. for multisector prevention of malnutrition.
- Participate in conducting nutrition situational analysis and other M&E activities as necessary under the guidance of the Roving officer, Nutrition Manager and the M& E manager, prepare detailed reports and recommendations where necessary.
- Supervise and provide technical guidance in the treatment of SAM, MAM and MIYCN services and the community-based activities such as nutrition screening, health education and defaulter tracing.
- To Prepare weekly, monthly and annual work plans to ensure that all projects are well supported and targets are met using indicator and activity tracking on your work plans.
- Ensure Nutrition Guidelines like CMAM and MIYCN and all Other related Nutrition activities that guide services delivery are available in all the OTP/TSFP sites
- Take a lead role in CMAM and MIYCN Training and mentoring of the Nutrition staff (CNWS, CNVs, MIYCN counsellors and the CHD Nutrition team
- Closely monitor utilization of nutrition supplies with up to date and accurate records in place.
- Responsible for supplies request at least one month before supplies run out of store completely, and is responsible for accountability of Nutrition drugs, supplies and Nutritional equipment
- Ensure timely submission of project advances and liquidations in line with the finance donor wise provided templates for smooth implementations of nutrition activities
- Facilitate coordination meetings, advocacy meetings and awareness raising sessions at the community level and represent UNIDOR in the local level coordination meetings with other NGOs, Donors, UN agencies and the local authorities
- Maintain effective working relationships with GOSS, SMOH, CHD, Nutrition department, Nutrition team and other NGOs for community-based organisations coordination

Qualifications/Experience

- Must be a South Sudanese national
- Must have University (or equivalent) degree in Food Nutrition and dietetics, nutrition and food science, community nutrition or public health nutrition.
- Minimum of 3 years in community-based management of acute malnutrition in NGO environment with at least 2 years' experience in emergency context.
- Be able to work in hardship area with minimum supervision
- Ability to maintain performance expectations in hardship conditions with limited resources
- Good computer skills with good knowledge of MS Offices and PowerPoint
- Fluent in Written and spoken English
- Excellent report writing skills, Training Skills and Advocacy skills with expertise in the use of NIS and DHIS2
- Must be sensitive with culture and respect the authority in the areas of operations
- Must be a team player with good inter-personal skills
