Overall Responsibility:

The Nutritionist / Food Security Field Supervisor will follow up and ensure achievement of the second outcome of the Project (i.e. target groups, small-scale farmers and pupils to get adequate and balanced nutrition). The Nutrition Supervisor provides training, demonstration and follow up on nutrition, balanced diets and hygienic food preparation practices to the target groups and contribute on the achievement of the objective of the project by promoting resilience, by strengthening nutrition awareness of vulnerable small-scale farmers and pupils (school's level) in Jubek State.

Essential job functions of a Nutritionist / Food Security Supervisor:

- ✓ Provide Technical guide / support to the Food Security team on the integration of the Nutrition and Food Security project.
- ✓ Strengthening the nutritional skill of the Parent-Teacher-Associations (PTA).
- Responsible for training of the community in basic nutrition skills: food consumption, balanced diet, nutrition values of the available food by establishing home & kitchen gardens.
- ✓ Conception and suggestion of the "Nutritional teaching materials" as part of the didactic material at the school level and for the Farmer groups.
- Participate in developing the nutrition training modules.

- ✓ Anthropometric assessments of beneficiary households for malnutrition; and then following the referral pathways in an event of identifying a malnourished child.
- ✓ Support in the use of the vegetables produce from the established Grey Water Towers at schools and household levels as an innovative strategy to improved agriculture systems and availability of the vegetables.
- ✓ Provide advice in good preservation practices of the different type of food at the households, farmer groups and to the targeted schools to ensure that the food taken in has retained its nutrients.
- ✓ Training the key nutrition and healthy diet related topics on "food cooking culinary demonstration" to the school children (to the Hygiene club and the Agricultural club); teachers and the farmer group at the community level.
- ✓ Training & demonstrations on good feeding practices to: the households (farmer groups); to the schools (Hygiene club and Agricultural club).
- ✓ Identify the most appropriate nutritional message regarding the target population and write clearly and understandable message.
- ✓ Organize, Mobilization and ensure active participation of the communities in project activities such as nutrition activities at Schools and Community level.
- ✓ Mobilize the communities on the importance of NUTRITION services through meetings, open air campaigns, radios, dialogues and other forms of advocacy/mobilization in communities around targeted schools and beneficiaries of the project in Juba location,
- ✓ Report the progress of the work to the supervisor, report possible problem or conflict during the activities, report the use of materials and possible improvement, data collection regarding the project and potential beneficiaries and regular reporting to PM.
- ✓ Participate in household assessments, distribution of nutritional items and support other nutrition related activities.
- ✓ Participate in office work with colleagues as a good team player
- ✓ Be an active role model towards population, by adhering to a healthy personal behavior and life style
- ✓ Maintain a non-judgmental and supportive attitude towards colleagues and beneficiaries regardless of their background.
- ✓ Take responsibility in representing Malteser International towards the local population, authorities and other (I)NGOs
- ✓ Adhere and respect Malteser International guidelines and codes be a good steward by ensuring that project materials and resources are used effectively.
- ✓ Ensure that NUTRITION activities are integrated with other activities for optimum benefit of the beneficiaries.
- ✓ Carry out additional tasks as reasonably requested by the PM or CC.

Qualifications:

- Diploma in Nutrition science or related fields.
- A bachelor's degree in the same domain will be an asset.
- Minimum of 2 to 3 years of experience in the same field.
