OBJECTIVES

- 1. Plan, develop, monitor and evaluate the assigned hygiene promotion component of the WASH projects.
- 2. Provide WASH technical support and capacity building hygiene promotion in the camp

Project planning, Implementation, monitoring and reporting

- Provides support and takes part to identify, facilitate and provide various training for hygiene promotion Assistants and WASH committee.
- Ensure project documentation of activities, best practices and lesson learnt are well captured and shared timely with the line manager or WASH PM.
- Monitors and follow-up to ensure proper dissemination of hygiene and sanitation messages to the beneficiaries.
- Provide technical guidance to hygiene team.
- Prepare detailed implementation plan, monitor and follow up on timely implementation of activities.
- Monitors the hygiene and sanitation situation in the camp and provides regular updates.
- Maintains close working relationships with community leadership, WASH committee and other stakeholders/ partners in the camp.
- organize monthly meeting with WASH committee.
- Take part in preparing all the required IEC/BCC materials and identifying and developing hygiene promotion messages.
- Take part in any WASH assessment, surveys and project evaluation in data collection, data entry and analysis.
- Collect, analyze and compile reports for hygiene and sanitation activities.
- Perform any other duties assigned by the line manager.
