



TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR SUPPLY OF WASH NFIs & MOSQUITO NETS

Project Name: Flood Emergency Response in Tonj East.

Background

Islamic Relief is an independent humanitarian and development UK based organization, with an active presence in over 40 countries across the globe, we strive to make the world a better and fairer place for people still living in poverty. Islamic Relief South Sudan began its humanitarian operation in South Sudan in 2004 focusing on providing life-saving aid and implementing developmental programmes to support people affected by drought and conflict by establishing three sub-offices in Narus (Kapoeta East), Wau, Warrap, a satellite office in Yei and its main offices in Juba.

IR through Flood Emergency Response Project in Tonj East is responding to the priority needs of the population affected by the flood in Tonj East County of Warrap state. The project is expected to contribute to improving the lives of the vulnerable population affected by the flood, to be achieved through improving access to clean and adequate water supply, improved sanitation, hygiene services and Malaria prevention Distribution of WASH NFIs and mosquito nets to meet the above mention objective. - Samples of items shall be provided for verification.
- All items will be delivered to Tonj East county – Warrap state (approximate distance from Wau town to Tonj east county is 140 kms and distance from Juba to Tonj east is approximately 776 kms)
- All quotations should include cost of the items, transportation, handling and any other related costs.
- Plastic jerry cans, plastic buckets and washing basins shall be branded on two sides with logos provided below.
- Provide an empty bag for packaging

REQUIREMENTS NEEDED FOR BIDDING

The Supplier is required to provide the following:

- i. Proven capacity and experience on borehole drilling for similar sectors in South Sudan.
- ii. Recent bank statement of proven financial capacity
- iii. Certificate of business registration from the government.
- iv. Second party will be responsible for any damage incurred during this process.
- v. Appropriate timelines to perform the assignment
- vi. Financial proposal indicating the cost rates and other charges applicable.
- vii. Availability to perform the assignment at the earliest possible time.
- viii. The above descriptions shall be strictly taken.

Mandatory Documents

The consultant/contractor shall submit the proposal with the following documents:-

- i. Company's profile
- ii. Company's technical capacity
- iii. Certificate of incorporation
- iv. PIN
- v. Recommendation from partners
- vi. Tax Clearance
- vii. Trade license
- viii. Bank statement

Language of the Bid

The bid, all correspondence & documents relating to the bid shall be in English language.

Cost of Bidding

The bidder/s shall bear all costs associated with preparation and submission of its bid. IRSS will in no case be responsible for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

Amendment of Bidding Document

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids IRSS may for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the bidding documents & will be binding on them. The amendment will be notified in writing or by email or letter to all prospective bidders, who have received the bidding documents & will be binding on them. In order to allow prospective bidders responsive time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their bids, IRSS may, at the discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the bids.

Bid Currencies

The bids prices shall be quoted in US Dollar (USD).

Bids Prices

- Prices quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for a period of four months i.e. during evaluation, award and implementation.

Award Criteria

The contract shall be awarded to the most economically advantageous bidder that meets quality, specification, delivery, price and good terms of payment.

IRSS is not bound to accept the highest, lowest or any other tender or bid, and is not bound to give any reasons thereof.

IRSS's right to vary quantities at the time of the award

IRSS reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease by up to 10% the quantity of work specified in the technical specification.

IRSS's right to accept any bid and reject any or all bids

IRSS reserves the right to accept any bid and to annul the bidding processes and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without, thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders on the grounds of its action.
