JOB VACANCY - COMMUNITY HEALTH EDUCATOR

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, humanitarian, non-governmental organisation providing assistance to people in need as a result of natural and man-made disasters, irrespective of race, religion, ideology or politics.

MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) is now looking for a qualified backup/daily workers pool of South Sudanese individuals that can be deployed as daily workers or contracted as needed. This backup/daily worker pool will be valid for 12 months from the date of final recruitment; successful candidates will be called to work as daily workers or contracted directly without any further recruitment procedure throughout this time period.

Position: Community Health Educator Number of Vacancies: Backup pool

Location: Mayen Abun, Twic County, Warrap State

Scope of responsibilities:

Prepare, provide and present health education sessions to the population/patients according MSF princi-ples and values in order to promote health information through health measures and hygiene conditions as well as provide information about MSF activities in order to facilitate access to healthcare

Main tasks:

• Prepare material and deliver health education sessions, messages and topics addressed to different populations regarding hygiene, diseases and prevention.

• Ensure all the patients and caretakers are well informed, according to protocols, about health related issues and services

- Monitor health situation and living conditions of the population by conducting nutritional screening, collecting information related to food security, checking vaccination status of children, looking actively for any defaulters in programs that require this type of research, collecting information on number of people arriving or leaving the community, births and deaths in the community, etc.
- Identify people with medical problems, contact with medical team and report for immediate transfer if needed. He/she has to inform to the line manager about any problem encountered (population, equipment, material...).
- Report to line manager of all results of screening and visits on a regular basis.

Recruitment criteria

Education:

Essential recognized public health certificate/Diploma or any relevant qualification.

Experience:

Desirable MSF experience. Essential 2 years of relevant working experience

Languages:

Fluent in English and Dinka language essential

Competencies:

Results orientation, teamwork, flexibility, commitment, stress management

South Sudanese candidates who meet the above criteria are invited to apply through the below link using a computer or a QR code on their smartphone. The deadline is no later than August 29, 2024 at 5:00pm.

Please online apply through online link, no hard copy application will be accepted.





Only short-listed candidates will be contacted. Female candidates are encouraged to apply.

Candidates are encouraged to apply early, as applications may be screened prior to the vacancy deadline.
