

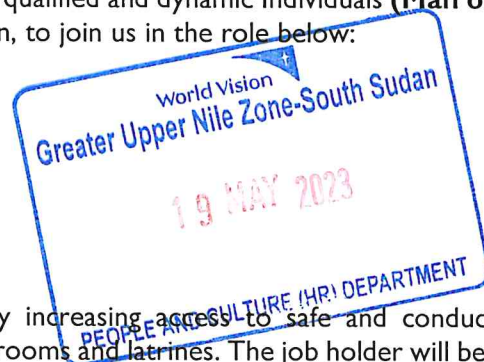

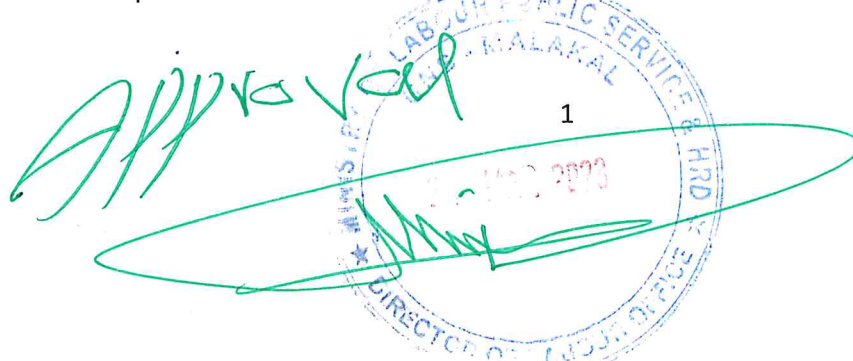


Purpose of the position:

To contribute to the achievement of project objectives by increasing access to safe and conducive learning environments through construction and rehabilitation of classrooms and latrines. The job holder will be responsible for coordination of successful implementation of education/protection interventions in the targeted schools in Malakal and Baliet Counties. Through a close collaboration with the State, and County Education Departments (CED), there will be compliance to the education systems, policies, guidelines and standards in an effort to strengthen them. This position mandates the bearer to prioritize the education portfolio planning, implementation, monitoring and follow ups.

Major roles and responsibilities:

- Help in executing already developed practical assessments, definition of technical documents and contracts for construction rehabilitation sites and regulation works.
- Support preparing BoQs and assist in verifying technical specifications and quality delivered by suppliers and/or engaged contractors.
- Support in ensuring thorough supervision of the works, guaranteeing that the contractors deliver according to technical designs and specifications and comply with IOM policy at all times.
- Assist in reviewing, updating and improving the preliminary Project Work Plan and drawings provided and ensure that they are followed to allow timely completion of milestones and appropriate use of resources.
- Support in facilitating appropriate community involvement and effectively involve other cluster partners in executing emergency response activities.
- Take programming decisions in consultation with County Education Departments in Malakal and Baliet Counties and only where budgets are not involved;
- Recruit seconded staff in written and approved consultations with the project manager and the county education departments in Malakal and Baliet counties.



Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/technical skills and experiences:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experiences or on-the-job trainings;

- South Sudanese Nationals only.
- Must hold a **Bachelor Degree in Civil engineering/Construction** from a recognized institution of learning with minimum of (5) years or related experiences as a Project construction engineer or a related role.
- Must be well versed with construction designs and layout as this forms an integral part of the main role.
- Must have computer knowledge, - (MS Word, excel and PowerPoint)
- Ability to work in a fragile context with harsh conditions and minimum infrastructures
- Must possess excellent interpersonal, communication and team building skills
- Must demonstrate Christ-centered life and work
