CMMB's Program Department plays a critical role in delivering a critical life-saving programs, ensuring quality health service delivery, capacity building and health infrastructure strengthening. CMMB's Program Management approach strives to efficiently and effectively





utilizes its resources in achieving its program goals through a cost effective and efficient system. The Department strives to ensure that all activities implemented are in compliance with CMMB policies, the National Ministry of health policies and donor compliance.

pharmacist plays a great role to assist health facilities by providing comprehensive support to health facilities, ensuring adequate and proper use of drugs, with extensive knowledge of how drugs interact with one another and the risks in various types of patients.

Main responsibilities include:

Order stock and ensuring that it is kept in appropriate condition

- Maintain accurate and detailed records of all medication in the drug store with stock cards
- Receive orders and release medicine to supported health facilities
- Train health facility focal persons keeping and dispensing drugs on drug management including preparation of drug consumption report and requisition of new drug order
- Ensure safe and clean working environment including drug store
- Complete operational requirements of the drug store, including verifying orders, maintaining records, and removing expired and / damaged drugs from drug store
- Conduct monthly and quarterly drug store inventory timely and submit report to line-manager
- Adhering to applicable legal rules, regulations, and procedures governing pharmaceutical practice
- Support and conduct regular monitoring and advice health facilities accordingly
- Performing other administrative tasks when needed.

- Bachelor's degree or Diploma in pharmacy or pharmacology with at least five (5) years' experience working in the field of pharmacy
- Proven experience as a pharmacist
- Valid license to practice as pharmacist
- Detailed understanding and knowledge of dosage requirements and administration, chemical compounds, and pharmaceutical brands.
