

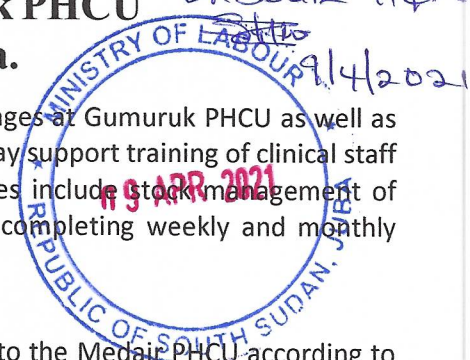

Clinical Officer- Gumuruk PHCU

Job Purpose: This position is responsible for consultations of patients of all ages at Gumuruk PHCU as well as supervision of other health staff providing consultations. On occasion they may support training of clinical staff or outreach activities in surrounding communities. Additional responsibilities include stock management of medical supplies, keeping accurate records, keeping health registries, and completing weekly and monthly reporting according to Medair specifications.

Clinical Duties

- To examine, diagnose, treat, and counsel all sick persons presenting to the Medair PHCU according to national and international guidelines for IEHC and outpatient services;
- Conduct regular triage of waiting beneficiaries to detect sick patients that need to be fast-tracked through consultation and treatment;
- Identify all children with danger signs or severe disease as per IEHC guidelines and all children with complications of severe acute malnutrition as per CMAM guidelines (action protocols). Give initial treatment and ensure referral to the PHCC or stabilisation center in a timely manner;
- Identify all children in need of vaccinations and refer to EPI services;
- Ensure appropriate health education is provided to the care takers of children attending the health and nutrition sites in group and individual sessions.
- Overall responsibility for appropriate implementation of COVID-19 prevention measures in the clinic and adherence by both staff and patients, including social distancing, use of face masks or other PPE, regular handwashing, regular cleaning and other IPC measures;
- Provision of essential health services to patients suspected to have COVID-19 with use of appropriate PPE and IPC measures;

Supervision

- Ensure the quality of the work of other health care staff, support and supervise as necessary to ensure proper care and treatment of patients at Lukuangole PHCU.

Reporting

- Ensure accurate record keeping in OPD cards, register books, and tally sheets.
- Compile weekly and monthly reports as per Medair and MoH requirements.
- Recognize and report symptoms of outbreak diseases and report through IDSR/EWARS.
- Line listing of outbreak diseases;

Stock management

- Ensure all medicines and other items for distribution are correctly stored.
- Ensure all stock is correctly recorded on stock cards and ensure daily physical counts are carried out for all supplies.

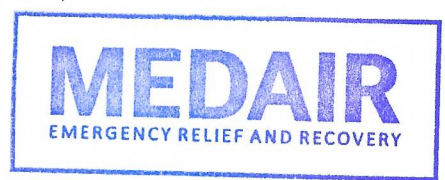
