Main Job Purpose:

Under the direct supervision of the Education Manager, the Head teacher will provide strategic school leadership, coordination with stakeholders, managing human resource, inspection and supervision, support in planning and implementation of ACROSS programs, teaching subjects like mathematics, science, and English.

JOB FUNCTIONS (Roles & Responsibilities):

- 1. Undertaking the weekly routine school duties.
- 2. Marking pupil's attendance in the class registers daily.
- 3. Compiling weekly activity reports.
- 4. Guiding pupils on sanitation & personal hygiene.
- 5. Continuously assessing the pupil's performance.
- 6. Provide guidance and counseling to pupils when need arises.
- 7. Keeping daily, monthly, termly & annual record of work.
- 8. Keeping pupils' progress record throughout the year.
- Guiding pupils during co-curricular activities (games/sports including Music, Dance & Drama).
- 10. Providing remedial teaching to the slow learners.
- 11. Checking pupils' discipline.



- 12. Prepare home learning materials and follow up pupils through phone communication.
- 13. Support control measures for the use of project resources/assets.
- 14. Uphold and adhere to ACROSS including child protection policies/procedures.
- 15. Playing other extra roles delegated upon by the School Administration and other relevant authorities.

 Certificate (Grade III) in Primary education or Diploma in education-primary with proof of training testimonials in the field of teaching. Possession of bachelor's degree in education primary will be an added advantage
