The GBV Officer will be responsible for contributing to the timely and quality implementation of activities, delivering continuous technical coaching, performing monitoring and evaluation of the quality of GBV-related work, and capacity building of staff who will be working with GBV prevention and response. The GBV officer will support the provision of training and supervising GBV social and Community Workers to respond to cases of GBV in the targeted areas and ensure effective case management and GBV prevention activities, respectively. She/He will oversee the implementation of the GBV program within their designated sites.

Key Responsibilities

- Initiate planning for longer-term GBV prevention and response activities, including referral pathways and standard operating procedures.
- Maintain, monitor, and measure GBV project implementation and contribute to effective information management on GBV survivors.
- Closely work with the protection Assistants/Caseworkers to ensure that staff implements and respects best practices and international standards in GBV prevention and response.
- Participate in the design of project activities, monitoring systems, and capacity-building activities for partners, community members, and children.
- Assist the GBV team in the development and testing of Behaviour Change Communication (BCC) materials on GBV and violence prevention for the camp communities.
