



Call for CALL FOR PROPOSAL (CFP):

Project title: Increased awareness of women and girls on their rights and discriminatory laws and enhanced access to justice through effective reform of formal and informal justice systems.

Background

For too many women around the world, justice remains an elusive and unfulfilled promise to mitigate against the realities they face in the home, the workplace and in communities. UN Women works to support the government of South Sudan in the areas of strengthening capacities of stakeholders to implement and assess progress in implementing global normative and policy frameworks that addresses gender discriminatory norms and laws; access to justice and establishment of transitional justice mechanisms; and support the drafting of a gendered permanent constitution. UN Women is therefore, seeking to partner with competent legal women led organizations in implementing a national level project titled: *“Increased awareness of women and girls on their rights and discriminatory laws and enhanced access to justice through effective reform of formal and informal justice systems.*

1. Scope of Work

The organizations to be selected will be expected to implement the programme outputs as stipulated in the project terms of reference (TOR) in close coordination and collaboration with UN Women, relevant national and state ministries, and other relevant UN Agencies. The project participants/beneficiaries must include rights holders, including women affected by conflict (and CRSV & GBV), duty bearers and women led advocacy networks working on access to justice, transitional justice and addressing discriminatory norms and laws.

3. Eligibility Criteria for the Expressions of Interests

- A valid registration Certificate with the South Sudanese Government, attached to the application.
- Extensive experience in project implementation using the common project-cycle management tools, including result-based management.
- At least 7 (seven) years demonstrated experience implementing legal and human rights based programmes on access to justice, law reform and transitional justice for CRSV and GBV, with a focus on gender equality and women empowerment within the South Sudan context.
- Track record of strong partnership with local communities, community-based organizations, and government agencies in previous assignments.
- Qualified core staff at field and management level in the above-described key result areas.
- Sound financial management and internal financial control system. Please attach certified audit reports for the most recent 2-3 previous fiscal years.
- At least 50% women on its Board and its staff, with substantive representation of women in key leadership positions. An organogram must be attached.
