AIM OF THE POSITION

The Health Field Officer 1, under supervision of the healthcare in detention doctor/nurse, contributes to the implementing, running and monitoring the healthcare service in detention, according to the objectives set out in the delegation's annual planning (Planning for Results) for a specific geographic area or field of activities.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Monitors and reports regularly health related activities in detention to the detention doctor/nurse: examination upon admission, availability of qualified health personnel, availability of drugs, availability of referral system, record keeping, drug stocks, consultations, medical statistics and individual medical files;
- Monitors and reports regarding specific individual medical cases that need to be monitored and/or referred to hospital, including special categories of detainees such as mentally-ill, TB and HIV/AIDS cases, pregnant and lactating women to the detention doctor/nurse;
- Identifies training needs of prison health staff and gives on the-job-training under the guidance of the detention doctor/nurse;
- Collects monthly health data and reports on time to the detention doctor/nurse;
- Supports the prison health staff and prison authorities in identifying & responding to health emergencies such as cholera, micronutrient deficiencies;
- Organizes and support prison health staff in health education (health promotion) and behavioral change campaign;
- Monitors the management of SAM cases by prison staff and ensures that all the information recorded are accurate and up-to-dated;
- Support the nutrition in detention in BMI activities on a quarterly basis;

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Medical doctor or nurse with 2 – 5years work experience in medical or public health fields;
- Advanced conversational and written in English and Juba Arabic (classical Arabic is an asset);

- Good knowledge of computer skills (word, excel, e-mail, internet);
- Skilled or capacity to develop skills in the following competencies: representing the ICRC, networking and communication, adapting and learning, responsibility and autonomy, communication (ability to express views and ideas), analysis and synthesis;
- Knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL, and of other humanitarian topics;
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment;
- Readiness to spend more than 75% of the time in the field;
- Driving license is an asset as well as a successful ICRC driving test.
