Overall Responsibility:

Program management.

Provides Day-to-day management of FSL activities, as directed by the project manager.

 Provides training/capacity building to key agricultural stakeholders e.g line ministries and farmers groups, with a focus on sustainable farming practices.

- Setup the demonstration plot for the farmer groups and the installation of school gardens.
- Responsible for the School gardens activities.
- Ensure Distribution of the agricultural items and the fishing kit to the farmers and to the schools.
