ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

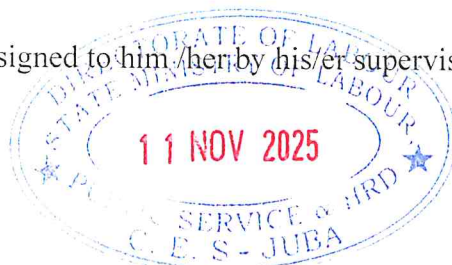
- Provide technical leadership related to project design and development, planning implementation, and overall project management of the FSL and GBV program

- Ensure formation of farmers groups and training conducted on GAPs for both vegetable farmers and cereals
