About HealthNet TPO:

HealthNet TPO, with global office in Netherlands, is a knowledge-driven, non-profit international organization that works in areas disrupted by conflict, disasters, and poverty. Working together with local populations, it prioritizes rehabilitation and development of health care services, and involves local communities in strengthening the health systems. We aim to contribute to improve the overall health situation and support the strengthening of the health systems for the provision of quality and sustainable health care for all populations.

HealthNet TPO is registered in South Sudan as an international NGO and has its country office in Juba and field offices in Terekeka, Raja, Aweil Counties and Kuajok. HealthNet TPO in coordination with the Ministry of Health, and in collaboration with several international and national NGOs provides live saving health care services, and Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services.

HealthNet TPO in a potential consortium with Crown Agents intends to implement a national Covid-19 vaccination campaign across 7 counties in South Sudan with an anticipated support and funding from UNICEF. The COVAX campaign will be conducted in 2 rounds each lasting for 3 months- September to November 2022 and January to March 2023. The campaign will be in the counties of Terekeka, Gogrial East, Gogrial West, Twic, Aweil North, Aweil West and Raja counties. The project envisages to contribute to the national Covid-19 efforts of the Government of South Sudan by ensuring that higher 40% eligible persons are fully immunized in the short term and eventual meeting the long-term global target of 70%.



Key roles and responsibilities:

In addition to ensuring an effective coordination with SMOH, CHD and local authorities and partners within the county of duty station, the consultant County focal person for Covid-19 campaigns is required to deliver the following results

- Deliverable-1: Consolidated County level micro-plans for the counties the HealthNet TPO will cover.
- Deliverable-2: Consolidated County level targets for the counties the partner will cover.
- Deliverable-3: SMOH/CHD/Community, and other stakeholders' engagement plan and implementation report.
- Deliverable-4: County level social mobilization, communication, and demand generation plan and implementation report.
- Deliverable 5: Submitted daily reports on MOH Open Data Kit (ODK) platform on the vaccination activity and people reached based on MOH approved format.
- Deliverable 6: Plan and report on the last mile distribution of vaccines and campaign materials.

Person specification

- At least three years of experience in non-government organizations in the field of public health, health systems strengthening, etc. in South Sudan. Good experience and knowledge of stakeholder coordination primarily with SmoH, CHD, partners etc.
- Excellent presentation and report writing skills including good understanding of data collection, analysis, presentation at local and national level platforms.
- Hands on experience in scheduling project activities, conduct the project activities as per the time and available budget and other resources.
- At least a diploma in one of the health or management streams including Medicine, Public Health, Project Management, Social Work, or other qualification closely related to the job.
- Excellent knowledge of computer software applications skills including Microsoft Office (Word, Power-point, Excel), database management software, etc.
- Language: English language proficiency is required. Good knowledge of Arabic language is an asset.
