The FSL Assistant will be responsible for most community activities in the FSL program such as beneficiary registration, mobilization for community meetings, formation of community structures for FSL and other sectors, beneficiary selection, registration of beneficiaries, community meetings, cash for training programme & unconditional cash transfer, CFW scheme selection, CFW scheme implementation, support cash distribution, complaint and feedback mechanism, post distribution monitoring, coordination with local stakeholders, and need assessments, participate in distribution, any
