To support the direct implementation of SSHF - II education sector activities that aim to contribute to access to quality education for conflict affected boys, girls and youth in Tonj South, Warrap State by Improving equitable access to safe and protective education, strengthen/enhance the education system's response capacity of the school community and education actors to mitigate the impact of existing emergency, education system at all levels and protect the wellbeing of all children, including children with disabilities and teachers' capacity to deliver quality services.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Program implementation establishment and implementation of all key project activities focused including implementation of ECD, primary education, AES, secondary education, ALP in accordance with the project documents and requirements
- Organize capacity building and quarterly on the job training for Volunteer Teachers, ECD facilitators,
 Parent Teachers Associations and School management committees, conduct frequent monitoring visits to schools supported by the project

 Equip the learning facilities with materials including hand washing facilities, disinfection and other items required to prevent the spread of coronavirus in the project sites

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- Liaise with Government officials and other partners wherever appropriate and required. Effectively represent WVS operations and mission when accompanying visitors to project sites.
- Provide mentoring, follow up, regular monitoring and technical support for Assistant project staff as needed in the field. Coordinate with MEAL Officer and Project Manager in updating required projects reporting templates and change stories.
