# **Background:**

In South Sudan, GIZ works on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) in the following three priority areas: Food and nutrition security and rural development, urban water supply and sanitation, rural development and good governance. GIZ's coordination office has been in the capital, Juba, since 2010.

The GIZ Coordination Office Juba is urgently seeking a qualified candidate to fill the vacant position of Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist for its Agriculture Bundle, consisting of three projects in agricultural development and food security.

# **Scope of the Position:**

Generally, the Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist works independently and in accordance with GIZ processes and rules. The Monitoring and Evaluation Officer responds promptly and competently to matters that fall within his/her assigned thematic area, where applicable in consultation with his/her line manager.

#### **Your Tasks**

- Support to the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Expert (based in Germany) in the development and implementation of an efficient context and conflict-sensitive results-based monitoring system;
- Support the M&E colleague in Germany in fulfilling the M&E requirements, including regular reporting to GIZ and commissioning parties (BMZ and others), on activities, outputs, impacts, and external risks, including quality assurance of data sets and data analysis;
- Independently design appropriate monitoring tools to track project progress and monitor the impact of project activities;
- Support implementing partner organizations in collecting data and relevant information for

- ongoing monitoring of project activities, results, impacts and assessment of external risks;
- Conduct regular visits to the implementing partners to check on progress of data collection and to advice on problem solutions;
- Liaise with project colleagues and external partners and coordinate knowledge transfer between the GIZ offices in South Sudan and Germany:
- Capacity building of program/project staff to ensure M&E tools are fully understood and used appropriately;
- Organize regular program/project reviews in consultation with the program staff to ensure implementations are on track.



### **Your Profile**

- Bachelor's degree in political, economic or social sciences, agricultural science, or equivalent;
- Minimum three years of professional experience in Monitoring and Evaluation (preferably with GIZ), in data collection and analysis, in aggregated reporting as well as in coordination and cooperation with external partners;
- Minimum two years of professional experience and knowledge in the fields of agriculture, rural development, food security;

- Excellent in-depth understanding of local contexts in the project regions (Northern Bar el Ghazal, Equatoria Region);
- Excellent communication skills, proven ability to draft and present complexities in easily understandable language, in a clear and target group-oriented manner;
- Strong digital skills, service orientation and ability to perform under time pressure;
- Business fluency in English.
