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Background ACTED

Objectives

To support in assessment, design, planning and implementation of infrastructure projects undertaken by ACTED in Maban and ensure timely achievement of project targets and objectives.



Duties and Responsibilities

Main duties:

Assessments and Project design

- Responsible for planning project implementation (including activity, financial and procurement planning).
- Coordinate any assessment or survey (e.g. needs assessment) relevant to the program.
- Assist in development and design of new projects in Maban County.
- Take part in the strategic planning, scheduling, monitoring and assessments, and evaluation of ACTED infrastructure projects
- Investigate and facilitate introduction of new technologies for permanent infrastructures in the camps.

Community mobilization

- Utilize community based approaches in the implementation of construction/rehabilitation projects and ensure mobilization of the communities and community leaders for building materials, construction activities and maintenance of structures.
- Ensure implementation of training sessions in care and maintenance of camp infrastructures.
- Take a leading role in designing and implementing necessary awareness raising activities as part of the participatory process
- Creatively problem solve with communities and local authorities in providing construction solutions.

Direct implementation of activities

- Responsible for the implementation of the construction project activities directly implemented by ACTED in Maban county, providing technical guidance and oversight resulting in quality construction of permanent and semi-permanent structures (e.g. communal structures, schools etc.)
- Ensure that all project activities are in accordance with budgetary constraints and being implemented on schedule.
- Make sure that all ACTED procurement and logistics policies are followed.
- Partake in tendering and bid analysis for contracts for service delivery and materials.
- Ensure that construction/rehabilitation is in accordance with national quality norms and standards
- Visit/supervise ACTED construction sites on regular basis.

Team management

- Supervision of construction team, maximizing team-work and inclusive approaches to management.
- Line manage Construction Assistants.

Monitoring and Reporting

- Timely reporting, on a weekly and monthly basis, regarding all construction activities in Maban County (identifying gaps, risks and bottlenecks that can obstruct proper implementation of activities)
- Ensure documentation of project progress is ongoing and integrate sound M&E procedures in all aspects of the project.
- Prepare documentation for final handover and closure of project.
- To follow up project costs and budgets lines related to project outputs

General

- Represent ACTED at relevant coordination meetings
- Coordinate activities with beneficiaries, relevant county authorities and other agencies in Bunj as well as in the field.
