- Overseeing training of church leaders, teachers and students' leaders on trauma healing and psychosocial support.
- Setting up SGBV counselling centres in churches and schools.
- Engage with the government and other key GBV stakeholders to enhance the implementation of GBV
- Organise and facilitate radio talk shows to create awareness on SGBV.
- · Facilitating the formation of GBV clubs in selected schools
- Attending coordination meetings including cluster meetings and ensuring that all stakeholder are involved in the project.
- With support form the GIO, develop necessary project reports
- Take lead in mainstreaming of GBV in all other projects implemented by CEDS
- Develop training materials and other GBV related
- Train organizational staff on different aspects of GBV and PSS.
- Ensuring that beneficiary accountability is fully applied during the project implementation.
