The principal objective of the Nutrition Assistant role is to implement World Vision supported nutrition activities at the Nutrition site and community level in line with project plan, and donor polices and agreed timelines in an integrated manner. This will include working together with CHD staffs, other partners staffs, Community Volunteers to mobilize communities, taking active part in identifying eligible targeting beneficiaries, establishing and training mother-to-mother support groups, Lead mothers, community structures and local leaders to become change agents in the community to influence health and nutrition practices and behaviors that promote good health.

- Conduct Community awareness sessions on malnutrition, causes, signs and symptoms and its prevention.
- Empower the community with Knowledge on: good nutrition, Optimal Maternal, Infant and Young Child Nutrition, Water sanitation and Hygiene practices, Environmental Hygiene, GBV, Good Health Seeking behaviors and Food Security Initiatives to promote Food and Nutrition security at household level.
- Identify training gaps among HHPs/Volunteers, organize on job training and refer trainings based on needs.
- Give feedback to CNVS/HHPs on delivery of nutrition services at community level.


