Job Summary

We are seeking an energetic, responsible candidate to join our Food and Nutrition Security (FNS) team in Malteser International based in Western Bahr El ghazal State, Wau Field Office for 12 months.

Main Job duties and responsibilities

- Provide technical guidance / support to the Food Security team on the integration of agribusiness in the Food and Nutrition Security project.
- Participate in the development of business guidelines, VSLA approach, design, and implementation of income generation activities.
- Lead and participate in household assessments, monitoring and market and value-chain studies to be conducted within the project implementation phase.
- Design and give specific training, workshops, and thematic events in agribusiness to other team members and to beneficiaries.
- Identifying market bottlenecks and opportunities for agricultural product value addition.



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- Design and implement a business monitoring methodology for the beneficiaries of project intervention.
- Building of competitive commodity value chains by linking improved productivity to increased value addition and downstream marketing.
- Assist agricultural extension supervisors in the identification of farmers' needs for the implementation/reinforcement of a market-led production (training, equipment, agricultural inputs, etc.)
- Promote improved techniques on Post Harvest Loss Reduction and Agro-Processing.
- Participate in the design and/or implementation of activities related to the promotion of youths and returnees' engagement in the agribusiness sector.
- Leading on communication about the agribusiness component to the local community, local government and traditional leadership and other stakeholders about the activities and community impact of the agribusinesses.
- Maintain a non-judgmental and supportive attitude towards colleagues and beneficiaries regardless of their background.
- Take responsibility in representing Malteser International towards the local population, authorities and other (I)NGOs
- Adhere and respect Malteser International guidelines and codes be a good steward by ensuring that project materials and resources are used effectively.
- Ensure that market led approaches are integrated with other activities for optimum benefit of the beneficiaries.
- Ability to incorporate value addition trainings to locally produced farm products.
- Integrate nutrition trainings including appropriate cooking demonstrations to the beneficiaries of the project.
