1. **Job Title:** **Health Manager**
2. **Organisation:** Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe e.V.,

3. **Organisation Description:** Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe e.V. ([www.thejohanniter.org](http://www.thejohanniter.org)) is a German Christian non-governmental organisation, dedicated to excellence in the field of first aid, ambulance service, social service programmes and other projects in the medical and social field. The Federal Headquarters are based in Berlin, Germany. Johanniter International Assistance is the operational unit for humanitarian aid, development co-operation and emergency relief, implementing and supporting mostly health projects world wide.
4. **Job Location:** **Wau State**
5. **Duration:** 5 months, with a High possibility of extension depending on Availability of funds and performance
6. **Project Description:**

Johanniter has secured UNICEF funds meant to implement an integrated nutrition, health and hygiene project in Jur River and Wau (Wau North, Baggari, Baselia & Bazia Payam) Counties, Wau State (former WBeG). The project duration is 3 years (2019-2021) depending of funding availability and organization performance. The project aims at addressing the gaps in prevention and treatment of malnutrition integrating hygiene and health components.

The project will also aim at ensuring the provision of quality services to vulnerable communities especially children under five years and pregnant and lactating women affected by conflict and displacement.

**7. Job Description:**

In addition to the specific duties outlined below, the Health Manager will be responsible for providing technical support and supervision to the health and nutrition sites; contributing to reporting, assessments and data collection; conducting monitoring visits to supported facilities; and providing technical input to program implementation, proposal writing and budgetary input for current and new projects. He/ She will work with the Team Leaders and Nutrition Advisor.

**8. Job Responsibilities:**

- Work closely with the Team Leaders, Nutrition Advisor and Project Coordinator to achieve program objectives and targets effectively and efficiently
- Help with activity verification and monitoring (stock and program quality) at supported facilities to ensure smooth, high-quality program implementation



- Facilitate coordination meetings, advocacy meetings and awareness raising sessions at the community level, together with community volunteers
- Assist the nutrition teams to prepare weekly and monthly workplans and reports
- Participate in conducting situational analysis and other M&E activities as necessary under the guidance of the Team Leaders, Nutrition Advisor and Project Coordinator
- Collect and compile project data regularly to submit to the Team Leaders, Nutrition Advisor and Project Coordinator including success stories and photographs of facilities.
- Provide regular updates on inventory of medical and non-medical items supported by the project (information / data collected through monitoring visits)
- Attend external meetings if and when assigned to represent Johanniter
- Improve the quality of primary health care (PHC) services delivered at supported facilities (Stabilization Center, Kangi Maternity and Maternity ward at new site-Wau South) throughout the State through priority setting, on-job training, and continuous monitoring
- Provide inputs for donor requirements for data collection and reporting for health and nutrition Projects in Wau State
- Work with M&E team to ensure program targets are met using indicator / activity tracking table
- Together with the M&E team, ensure the quality of data through proper entry, cleaning and regular checking and use the data for action on the site
- Ensure diagnosis and treatment of patients is based on standard procedures (national and international guidelines)
- Ensure the community based activities such as EPI, nutrition screening, health education and defaulter tracing are done properly
- Actively participate in the identification and management of any disaster or epidemics
- Build the capacity of facility staffs through proper coaching and training

- More than 3 years post-qualification medical professional experience
- Experience working in a health programme or experience working in nutrition programme preferably in a humanitarian context. Previous experience managing nutrition programming (TSFP, OTP, SC) is strongly recommended

- Skilled in, and committed to, community participation/interaction, field visits and presence in program areas
- Able to set clear objectives and to delegate. Good organisational skills
- Good communicator with proven diplomacy who has the ability and willingness to engage with all levels of staff and all types of stakeholders
- Team-player with good inter-personal skills
- Capacity to work under pressure and manage personal stress levels
- Program management experience and/or community development; previous experience in area management
