Purpose of the position:

World Vision is providing essential health care services in South Sudan, with interventions in Yambio and Nzara Counties, Western Equatoria State, designed to: enhance delivery of integrated health services, expand community health services for prevention and treatment, and support stable health systems that are responsive and accountable to the needs of communities and individuals accessing these services. To ensure thoughtful implementation considering the unique needs of vulnerable and at-risk groups, World Vision is seeking a Paediatrician to based at Yambio State Hospital.

In order to improve child indicators, a paediatrician is required to provide quality clinical care in the OPD and Pediatric ward through clinical rounds, conducting regular departmental meetings, Continuous Medical Education (CME) and monitoring of commodities consumption.

The Paediatrician will work closely with the Medical Director, Medical officers, Clinical Officers and Nurses to improve the quality of care in the department. He/she will ensure that HPF 3 Lot 8 project indicators in the Pediatrics Unit are on track through close collaboration with the Hospital, M&E and MNCH Coordinators.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- o Provide high quality clinical care to children in the OPD and pediatric ward.
- Perform ward rounds in pediatric ward and provide the necessary care according to the identified patient needs.



- Manage all pediatric cases in line with South Sudan treatment guidelines and protocol and participate in supportive supervision and mentorship of junior staff and provide on the job training as needed.
- O Participate in monitoring the drugs and medical consumables to ensure cost effective utilization of medicines and medical supplies. Additionally, guide the medical officers in preparation of equipment, drugs and medical consumables requests.
- Provide capacity building to junior doctors and other staff in Yambio State Hospital.
 He/she will assist with developing teaching resources, materials and programs for the clinical officers, medical officers and nursing staff.

Knowledge/Qualifications for the Role.

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal, prior experience or on-thejob training:

- Two or more years' experience post qualification in clinical work with the government or private or hospital practice.
- Experience in working with NGOS in humanitarian setting is preferred.
- Experience in a management role, supervision and mentoring junior clinical staff preferred.
- Medical degree (MD, MBChB) and master's degree in pediatrics from a recognized medical institution.
- · Licensed to Practice by the Medical Council of South Sudan or similar regulatory authority.
- Excellent verbal and written use of the English language required;
- Strong communication skills especially with those of different cultures, with excellent written and spoken English and Arabic is preferred.
- Personnel management and motivation expertise and experience.
- Good understanding of the political and cultural context of South Sudan
