Purpose of the position:

World Vision South Sudan is supporting the Ministry of Public Utilities in South Sudan to develop a sustainable revenue collection system for Baliet Town, Kodok Town, and Malakal Town. This initiative seeks to ensure equitable access to water resources while promoting community engagement and financial sustainability. To achieve this goal, WVSS and the Ministry seek the expertise of a Utilities Management Specialist (Community Engagement) for a period of six months.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Objectives:

The Utilities Management Specialist will spearhead the following tasks:

- Conduct an initial consultative meeting with Ministry leadership to launch the initiative, define goals, and establish deliverables.
- Conduct stakeholder consultations in Baliet Town, Kodok Town, and Malakal Town to assess interest and feasibility of the revenue collection system. Stakeholders to include representatives from vulnerable groups such as women, youth, the elderly, and people with special needs.
- Draft a revenue collection model incorporating a tier system based on water usage (quantity) and purpose.
- Explore the feasibility of individual household connections and implement a metered system for households capable of affording it.
- Develop a strategy for managing and levying water collected at public water points.

Scope of Work:



- Initiate and facilitate an inclusive consultative process with Ministry leadership to establish project objectives and deliverables.
- Organize and conduct stakeholder consultations in Baliet Town, Kodok Town, and Malakal Town, ensuring representation from diverse community segments.
- Analyze findings from stakeholder consultations and develop a comprehensive revenue collection model, emphasizing equity and sustainability.
- Assess the practicality of individual household connections and propose a metering system for households with financial capability.
- Design a transparent and accountable mechanism for managing water collection and levies at public water points.

Deliverables:

- Report on initial consultative meeting with Ministry leadership, including defined goals and deliverables.
- Comprehensive report on stakeholder consultations, including insights gathered and recommendations for the revenue collection model.
- Draft revenue collection model document outlining the tier system for pricing based on water usage and purpose.
- Feasibility assessment report on individual household connections and metered system proposal.
- Strategy document detailing the management and levying of water collected at public water points.

Reporting and Supervision:

- The Utilities Management Specialist will report directly to the RESTORE Project Director with matrix reporting to the designated authority within the Ministry of Public Utilities.

Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience.

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

Minimum Qualification required: Bachelor Degree in (state the relevant discipline)

- A Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Management, Water Resources Management or Sociology.
- A minimum of 5 years of experience in Water utilities management, project management, community engagement, or related fields.
- Proven track record in facilitating stakeholder consultations and developing sustainable revenue collection systems.
- Strong analytical and report-writing skills.
- Familiarity with the socio-economic context of South Sudan, particularly in the specified towns, is highly desirable.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to engage diverse stakeholders effectively.
