### 1. Background

The Afia WASH project is a five-year, USAID funded project (October 2021-September 2026) that aims expand gender-transformative and sustainable access to basic safe drinking water, basic sanitation coverage, and increased uptake of key hygiene behaviors for the purpose of improving health and household resilience in accordance with USAID/South Sudan's Strategic Framework 2020 – 2024. This goal will be achieved through the following three objectives.

1. Strengthening sub-national and private WASH sector coordination and management.
2. Expanding and strengthening inclusive, resilient, WASH deliver.
3. Ensuring key WASH behaviors adopted by target communities and harmful gender norms addressed.

The project is being implemented by DT Global (<https://dt-global.com/>) an international development contractor, working across a wide range of sectors including WASH and technical areas in over 90 countries around the world. DT Global South Sudan - Afia WASH Project is therefore inviting interested, eligible and competent Construction Firms; Civil society organization and Service providers via this Expression of Interest (EOI) to respond on their willingness to be shortlisted to construct new and rehabilitate existing WASH infrastructure in any of the following counties in South Sudan:

1. Wau and Jur river in Western Bar-el-ghazel State
2. Kapoeta and Budi in Eastern Equatoria State
3. Akobo, Uror and Duk Counties in Jonglei State
4. Pibor in Greater Pibor Administrative Area

### 2. Objectives

The overall objectives are to dramatically strengthen inclusive, resilient services through a dual focus on sustainable service expansion through infrastructure development and professionalized operations and maintenance (O&M).

Below is the list of infrastructure development activities to be undertaken between January 2023 and July 2023:.

- Drilling of boreholes and installation of Indian Mark II handpumps
- Drilling of boreholes and installation of solar powered water yards
- Rehabilitation of existing water yards
- Upgrading of high yielding boreholes into water yards
- Construction of a public toilet
- Construction of disability/child-friendly school VIP (ventilated improved pit) latrines with four stances, one changing space for girls, and urinal annex for boys. Each latrine block must have a handwashing station
- Manual drilling wells fitted with India Mark II hand pump
- Rehabilitation of Hand pumps
- Spring protection

### 3. Eligibility/Criteria for selection

Applicant organizations will only be considered if they are:

- Legally registered in South Sudan with valid legal business certificate
- Have been in operation for at least three years from the time of registration
- Physical Presence or have experience working in the counties where the activities will be conducted (*All these three points should not exceed one page*)
- Demonstrated capacity in the proposed assignment [Give a list of the last similar assignments that you have undertaken] – Not more than 2 pages
- Availability of reputable experts in the specialties of the assignment [We are not looking for CVs, however, give staff list, qualification and experience – not more than one third of the paper for each technical staff] – (*Not more than 3 pages.*)
- Proven organizational capacity (Give brief on your experience on similar assignments) i.e. experience in construction and rehabilitation of WASH infrastructure. (*Nor more than 3 pages*)

Bidders are required to provide contact details and at least two (2) letters of satisfactory completion of assignments of a similar nature.

### 4. Mode of Submission:

- Applicants must submit adequate information on their Legal corporate status, including but not limited to Company Name, proof of Physical Location, Telephone number, and Contact person
- Applicants should indicate their capacity to provide the services This information should include past verifiable performance of similar assignments undertaken and should include contact person(s) for reference.
- If you get shortlisted, your organizations will receive a Request for Proposal (RFP) requesting you to submit full detailed Technical and Financial proposals separately. The exercise towards realizing contract award shall be transparent and competitive.
- Interested organizations **MUST** submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) to the email indicated below not later than **December 5, 2022, 5:00pm, Juba time.**
- Applicants Must indicate clearly on e-mail address the assignment or service, including the county(ies) they are interested in. If the firm is interested in more than one county, then they should submit a separate EOI for each of the counties for their interests.

### 5. Submission Guidelines

EOI should be in English Language and not exceed ten (10) pages as (excluding cover page, executive summary and annexes). Any EOI with more than 10 pages **will NOT BE** considered responsive at all and will be rejected.
