AIM OF THE POSITION

Health Field Officer 1 contributes to implementing, running and monitoring the health programme (s), in cooperation with the health team, according to the objectives set out in the delegation's annual planning (Planning for Results) for a specific geographic area or field of activities.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Implements health programmes in his/her geographic area or field of responsibility/expertise.
- Conducts assessments and regular field visits (as relevant) to monitor activities and health-related threats to the population.
- Facilitates field trips (as relevant) and helps communicate with the local population/victims/beneficiaries.
- Ensures proper management of information collected and produces the subsequent reports.
- Participates in analysis of and reflection on the overall health situation; contributes to realistic project proposals in line with the delegation's objectives and priorities.
- Helps organize meetings; advises staff members on matters such as culture, politics, the economy, security, etc.
- Interprets at meetings and translates documents into local languages.
- Carries out logistical tasks regarding medical items, including for staff-health issues, and organizes distributions to beneficiaries in the field when required.
- Liaises and builds networks with local stakeholders to facilitate communication on and coordination of activities, thereby ensuring more efficient implementation of health programmes.
- In coordination with the Health Delegate, liaises with South Sudan Red Cross Society (SSRCS)
- Support and participate in the baseline assessment and project plan development process specific to communities;
- Support and help to facilitate project evaluations such as final project evaluation;
- Assist in the compilation, review and preparation of project documents and ensure that indicators are clearly and accurately incorporated; collect regular project data and submit to the line manager;
- Support and participate in the volunteers review and monthly meetings wherever possible;
- Prepare periodic progress reports and submit to the line manager;

- Document project implementation status, success, failure, lessons learned, and thematic anecdotes that contributed project outcome/output;
- Monitor the training outcome/impact through follow up visits;

- Strengthen community health volunteer's training/facilitation skill through on site coaching and mentoring;

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Degree in medicine, nursing or other relevant health profession (e.g. psychology).
- Qualifications in public health or health management will be a strong asset.
- Fluent written and spoken command of English and/or Arabic.
- Good connections with local health authorities or groups of interest for the ICRC.
- 3-5 years of experience in humanitarian work / Health.
- Minimum 2 years work in relevant clinical context.
- Good level of computer.
- Good knowledge of the assigned geographic area.
- Skilled in the following competencies; Representing the ICRC; Networking & Communication; adapting & learning, Responsibility (ability to express views and ideas), Analysis and synthesis.
