PAH in South Sudan:

PAH has been working in South Sudan since 2006 as one of the first NGOs established in Jonglei State. We are a small team of committed individuals aiming at delivering tangible and sustainable change in the largest, most populous and most conflicted state of South Sudan. We are needs- and community based, hence aside drilling and repairing boreholes, developing accompanying O&M structures and innovative approaches to sanitation and hygiene promotion, we have also been developing our emergency response capacity. Our Emergency Response Team (ERT) mainly reacts to WASH and NFI needs of populations affected by conflicts and natural disasters, which have been on the increase for the past three years. Thanks to the expertise gathered over the years, we were also appointed to lead WASH Cluster in the state: we coordinate WASH emergency response with partners and hence make sure all vulnerable communities are served at the time of crisis.

Scope of work

- Ensure joint targeting, verification, registration, and distribution processes of ES/NFI In-kind.
- Establish transparent and functional relationship with target communities, and worked with all levels of government officials.
- Ensure that the Shelter-NFI activities are implemented according to the approved donor and government agreements.
- Actively participate in ES/NFI needs assessment.
- Prepare detail work plan, cash transfer for procurement of materials, implementation, monitoring, reporting and review of response activities as per the agreed document with donor and partners.
- Document and share lesson learned in related with ES-NFI
- Ensure cash transferred to the target HH as per planned cluster transfer value if CBI is involved.
- Identify the ES/NFI needs for affected populations through assessments.
- Facilitate appropriate verification and registration processes for affected populations.
- Lead and facilitate appropriate distributions to meet identified ES/NFI needs for affected populations.
- facilitate post-distribution monitoring exercises.
- Coordinate with ES/NFI partners in field locations during targeting, distributions, and PDM.
- Write analysis, distribution, and post-distribution monitoring (PDM) reports for internal and external dissemination in coordination with the field-based Project coordinator
- Attend meetings woreda and zonal level.
