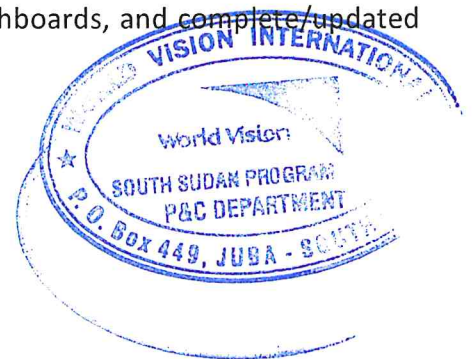
Purpose of the position:

To spur innovation and adoption of digitized monitoring, evaluation, accountability, reporting, and learning. The role will preposition WV South Sudan to achieve cost optimization leveraging on technology to achieve efficiency and effectiveness, and support scale-up/ adoption of World Vision International partnership innovations/technology such as impact reporting pilot for fragile states, LMMS, Compare, Box-Be or new trending technologies/digital data analytics, apps. In FY21, WV South Sudan will pilot an initiative, “Data within 5 minutes” hence this role is instrumental in achieving this initiative.

Major Activities

Innovative information systems for monitoring, evaluation and accountability

- In liaison with ICT department, rollout information systems adopted by World Vision Global Center and South Sudan to support data collection, aggregation, reporting and dissemination.
- Support projects to achieve standardized real-time data capture in digital formats compatible with a range of platforms e.g. XLS forms, rich media, geo-cord data in CSV or shape files convertible formats useable with GIS apps.
- Collaborate with quality assurance/M&E coordinators, programme officers, and project directors/managers to maintain updated impact reporting dashboards, and complete/updated project profiles/documents on Horizon



- In addition, ensure impact dashboard and country database are updated with project data submitted to external management info systems e.g. HMIS, NIS, Cluster 5Ws, JMMI, and GBV MIS among others
- Support projects to achieve real-time tracking of Child Well-Being indicators, interventions and assets using digital solutions/platforms/tools
- Leverage on existing or emerging technology to achieve real-time end-to-end accountability to project stakeholders.
- Achieve integration of mobile technology platforms such as LMMS, ONA, SMAP, ODK, or new mobile data collection technologies into process, output and outcome monitoring.
- Maintain updated ready to use household survey modules in both on-line versions and XLS coded formats/sheets.
- Support projects to generate periodic reports using digital data platforms to collect and generate datasets as abstracts, summaries and visuals through GIS and relevant safe apps
- Support project staff to understand and use technologies through mentorship and training

Knowledge Management

- Collaborate with projects to generate evidence of how technology, improve quality of the humanitarian response
- Identify new areas of technology through pilots and participating in working groups relevant to the organization and for achieving child well-being
- Collaborate with communications and sector leads to collate and disseminate data to donors, communities, and partners.
- Promote information sharing through safe formal and informal platforms/technologies.
- Provide costed solutions for project design/concept Support global center and field office pilots, research or documentation using digital solutions and learning associated with use of technologies
- Support projects to achieve learning and information sharing using interactive tools, forums, or platforms
- When required, support development of research areas around technology and humanitarian assistance
- Participate in the analysis of trends generated from monitoring and evaluations
- Collaborate with quality assurance/M&E coordinators to generate information for learning events. This includes design of clear tools and guidelines to facilitate lessons learned events.

Reporting

- Improve project participant tracking, avoiding double counting using QR codes or bar-codes to track and report progress on project participants
- Support projects to use technology to achieve data quality parameters of completeness, consistency, conformity, accuracy, integrity, and timeliness.
- Conduct data quality audits using digital review apps to ensure quality of data meets quality standards.
- Support the zonal teams to review and generate zonal level aggregated reports.
