Purpose of the position:

The primary aim of this consultancy is to ensure that the guiding materials for support climate-responsive extension services developed by the project are translated into local languages, and repackaged. This includes translating, simplifying, illustrating and, designing training materials and advisory packages so they are understandable and usable by semi-literate and non-literate community members, including women, youth, farmers, and pastoralists. The consultancy work will start on 1st April, 2026 and all the processes must be completed **within 45 days** of signing the contractual agreement. The timeframe includes submission of reports. The task is very time sensitive, and hence in the work plan the Local Communication Specialist should present in detail how he/she will adhere to this timeframe.

TASKS AND DELIVERABLES:

The Local Communication Specialist will ensure the following tasks are accomplished:

- **Inception:** Review materials provided by World Vision and submit an inception report.
- **Translation:** Contextualize, translate and simplify project documents package provided by World Vision into Dinka, Luo and Arabic. This includes reports, training manuals/modules/packages and technical guidelines. Validate translation with local community to ensure cultural and linguistic appropriateness of translations.
- **Illustration & Visual Design:** Develop low-literacy friendly materials, such as posters, picture guides, infographics and community training cards.

- **Audio & Video Production:** Convert materials into radio scripts, Produce short audio messages for dissemination through community radio and megaphones. Produce instructional videos.
- **Repackaging materials** for print, social media and web-based distribution.
- **Pre-testing & Refinement:** Pre-test materials with users and refine based on feedback.

The Communication Specialist will ensure the following deliverables are met:

- A detailed Inception report.
- Translated versions in required languages.
- Illustrated/visual training packages (print-ready formats).
- Radio scripts, video and audio products.
- Digital files (in editable formats).

- Final consolidated package ready for use by extension teams.

Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

- Advanced Degree in the area of Mass Communication, Media, or a related discipline.
- More than 5 years of experience in implementing or managing similar works.
- At least 5 years' experience in facilitating TOT and subsequent monitoring of TOT participants.
- Well experienced in development and translation of training materials.
- Previous experiences in similar works with recorded levels of success is desirable.
- Good understanding of South Sudan social and political context.
- Familiarity with the local economic environment of South Sudan and East Africa is an advantage.
- Impeccable communication skills, especially with adult learners and semi-illiterate participants.
- Good command of English, both written and spoken.
- Understanding of Dinka, Luo and Arabic languages is a **MUST**.
- Experience in social media.
