In South Sudan, GIZ works on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development in the following three priority areas: Agriculture and Food Security, Urban water supply and sanitation, Rural development and good governance. GIZ's coordination office has been in the capital, Juba, since 2010.

The GIZ Coordination Office Juba is urgently seeking (2) qualified candidates to fill the vacant positions of Junior Technical Advisor – Agriculture and Food Security in Aweil and Yambio, for its project "Food Security and Management of Natural Resources".

Scope of the Position:

Generally, the Junior Technical Advisor works independently with guidelines defined by the Head of Component, and in accordance with GIZ processes and rules. The Junior Technical Advisor responds promptly and competently to matters that fall within his/her assigned thematic area, where applicable in consultation with his/her line manager.

Your Tasks

- Support the Senior Agriculture Advisor and project team in the delivery of agricultural extension services, trainings, and monitoring
- Visit farmers on a regular basis to provide knowledge, advice, and skills on best agronomic practices
- Support capacity building (e.g. trainings) of farmers and monitor farmer's performance
- Promote community participation in agriculture and livelihood activities
- Prepare and submit activity progress reports to the Senior Agriculture Advisor, including accurate records of all agricultural activities
- Support the Monitoring and Evaluation officer and consultants to collect project data
- Represent GIZ in Coordination group meetings (e.g. cluster) in the absence of the Senior Agriculture Advisor
- Facilitate regular meetings and coordination with key stakeholders
- Perform any other duty as required by the supervisor
