

PREQUALIFICATION OF GOODS, WORKS AND SERVICES FOR 2023/2024

ForAfrika procures goods and services on a regular basis throughout the year, as programme demands dictate. We are now pre-qualifying suppliers for a range of regularly procured items, to streamline our procurement process each time we need to source the items. In most of the procurement processes ForAfrika ensures that competitive prices and value for money is obtained by way of “Competitive Negotiated Procedure”. Through our prequalification process, **a minimum of five suppliers will be shortlisted for each category of items whom ForAfrika will use for the next 18 months.** ForAfrika will only shortlist suppliers that meet our demands and that the terms and conditions match what is agreed as part of the pre-qualification agreement.
