REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Norwegian Church Aid South Sudan invites Faith based organisations, CSOs and CBOs to express interest in partnering for the implementation of 2025-2029 strategy focusing on climate resilience water, sanitation and hygiene, in Eastern Equatoria and Warrap states.

Background

Norwegian Church Aid (NCA) is an ecumenical, diaconal, humanitarian and non-profit Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) mandated by churches and Christian organizations in Norway to work for global justice, by empowering the poor and challenging the wealthy and powerful. Together with our constituency and our partners, NCA commits to the vision: Together for a Just World. Based on the Christian faith, NCA works for the benefit of the poor, destitute and oppressed – regardless of gender, race, political opinion or religion. In South Sudan, NCA implements programs focusing on Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH), Economic Development and Food Security, Peacebuilding, Gender-Based Violence (GBV).

This call for EOI is specifically targeting NNGOs and Faith-based Organization with a strong operational presence in **Eastern Equatoria State (EES)** and/or **Warrap State**.

Objectives of the Expression of Interest

The EOI aims to identify organisations to partner with NCA in delivering WASH projects aligned with the 2025-2029 strategy. The key objectives include

- Construction and rehabilitation of resilient water infrastructure points (e.g., raised platforms, solar-powered water yards) and sanitation facilities.
- Implementing Integrated Water Resource Management (IWRM) plans and conducting community mapping for climate risks.
- **Promote** hygiene awareness (CLTS/PHAST) with a focus on climate adaptation and disease prevention during climate shocks.
- Training of Water Management Committees (WMCs) on operation, maintenance, and climate resilience.
- Promote social cohesion and inclusion at all levels

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for this partnership, the NNGO and faith-based organisations should meet the following mandatory requirements:

- a. **Legal Registration:** Valid Registration Certificate from the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) and the Ministry of Justice.
- b. **Faith based organisation with community outreach and multisectoral development and humanitarian focus**
- c. **Civil Society organisations working across WASH with demonstrated experience in the thematic areas in the targeted states.**
- d. **Operational Presence:** Physical office and staff presence in the target states (EES or Warrap).

- e. **Experience:** Minimum of 5 years of experience continually implementing WASH projects in South Sudan. Experience with *Climate Resilient* infrastructures is a distinct advantage.
- f. **Financial Capacity:** Proof of a functional bank account and audited financial statements for the last 3 years. This should include Annual consolidated Budget for the same period.
- g. **Compliance:** Tax Clearance Certificate

Submission Requirements

Interested NNGOs should submit an EOI dossier containing the following:

a. Technical Profile (Max 15 Pages)

- Brief history of the organization.
- List of current and past WASH projects (donor, budget, location, and status).
- Specific experience in EES or Warrap State.
- Approach to Climate Resilience in WASH (brief methodology).
- Approach to community Engagement and Community Capacity building

b. Administrative Documents

- Copy of valid RRC Registration.
- Copy of Tax Identification Number (TIN) and Tax Clearance.
- Organogram/Structure of the organization.
- List of Board of Directors with their contacts information
- Minutes of the last meeting of the Board of Directors

Applications will be evaluated based on:

1. **Relevance:** Alignment with NCA's CRWASH strategic priorities.
2. **Capacity:** Technical and financial capability to deliver.
3. **Local Presence:** Depth of community engagement in EES or Warrap.
4. **Innovative** approaches to climate Resilient WASH.
