Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) has been working in today's South Sudan since the late 1990's. Since the country's independence in 2011, Welthungerhilfe has implemented 87 projects ranging from rapid disaster relief to reconstruction and long-term development cooperation projects with local partners, with an overall volume of over EUR 420 million. Through 19 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Eastern Equatoria), we supported 610,000 people in 2020 alone. Welthungerhilfe receives institutional grants from German federal funds (GFFO, BMZ, GIZ), UN (WFP, FAO, SSHF) and the European Trust Fund (EUTF). WHH SSD primary areas of work in South Sudan are food security, agriculture, food systems, nutrition, WASH and infrastructure rehabilitation, under the overarching umbrella of climate resilience and adaptation. Established in Germany in 1962 under FAO-led campaign against hunger, currently operates in 36 countries globally.

Project background:

The Field Coordinator - Agriculture will work with the respective program staff, Government structures, WFP, and other stakeholders to identify areas that have good potentials for Asset Creation and livelihood activities especially focussed on Food security and Livelihoods to build and enhance resilience for the community in Mayom County, Unity State in South Sudan. The Candidate will have a strong background in agriculture and have adequate experience and skills on asset creation and livelihood implementation.





Key responsibilities:

- Plan, coordinate and provide technical oversight in the timely implementation of Cash for Asset project activities.
- Provide the project team with field level day-to-day technical guides for better performance and operation
- Ensure project team members are aware and understand the tasks and timeframe
- In coordination with MEAL officer and Head of project, Support and coordinate food security & infrastructure related assessments as may be required.
- Attend Food Security and Cash Transfer coordination meeting and provide regular update to local government officials.
- Oversee Cash Based Transfer activities under the CFA project.
- Provide technical oversight to agriculture / infrastructure activities under CFA Project.
- Ensure staff are oriented to follow and adhere to the activity Standard Operating Procedures (SoPs).
- Prepare accurate and timely Cash For Assets related reports for review by the Head of Project.
- Conduct joint monitoring visit together with stakeholders in the project locations.
- Represent the project and Welthungerhilfe at various meetings and stakeholder coordination fora at Payam, County and State level
- Ensure project team members are aware and understand the tasks and timeframe
- Produce and share activity specific, monthly and weekly reports
