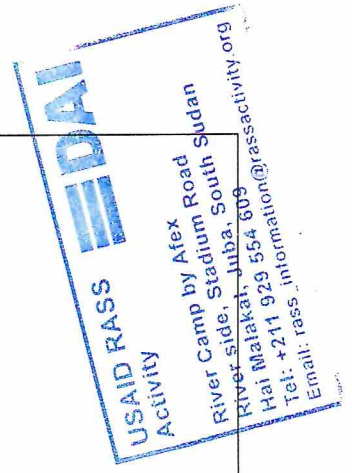

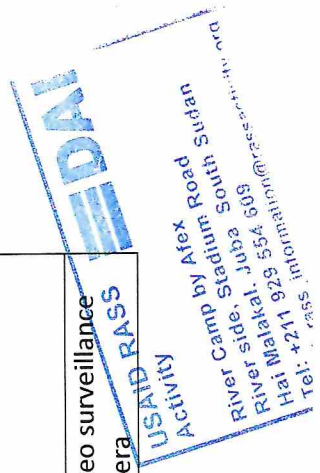

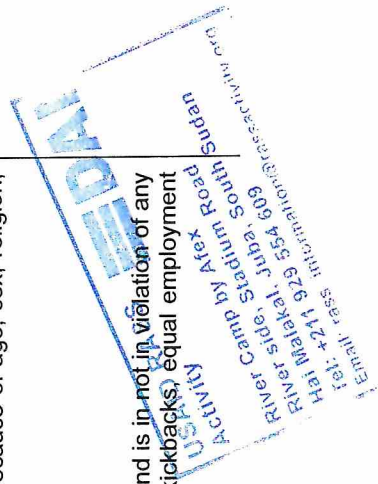

1.2 Attachment B: Representations and Certifications of Compliance

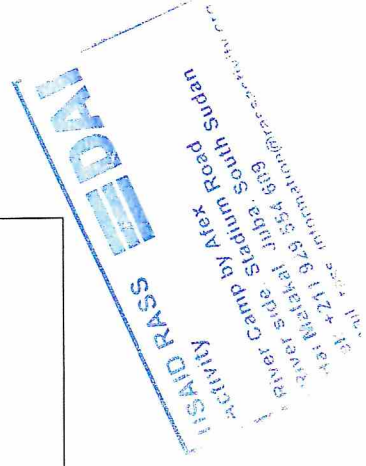
