## **Background:**

In South Sudan, GIZ works on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development in the following three priority areas: Food and nutrition security and rural development, Urban water supply and sanitation, Rural development and good governance. GIZ's coordination office has been in the capital, Juba, since 2010.

The GIZ Coordination Office Juba is seeking a qualified candidate to fill the vacant position of **Technical Advisor** Peace Education and Social Cohesion for the new Project Local Governance and strengthening of peaceful coexistence in South Sudan.

### **Scope of the Position:**

Generally, the Technical Advisor in consultation with the line manager, makes technical and substantive contributions to overarching issues in cooperation with commissioning parties/clients, partners & other actors and thereby support the achievement of the agreed objectives, of the respective project and provide impetus for further strategy development. The technical advisor is foreseen to support 2 out of 4 outputs of the project.

#### **Your Tasks**

- Planning, Implementing, Monitoring and Reporting of activities in Output 3 (working with women and youth organizations for peace on the local level, support income generating activities) and Output 4 (Sport for Development) in close cooperation with the project coordinator and project manager
- Steer the cooperation with women and youth organizations and manage small grants.
- Engage with regional GIZ project on Sports for Development.
- Act as Gender focal point for all related activities of the project
- Provide input and develop ideas for communication materials.
- Support overall project activities, outputs and outcomes.

- Build partnerships with actors, networks and organization and advise in cooperation with other thematic advisors in the field of peace, social cohesion and local governance
- Cooperate closely with other Governancerelated projects of GIZ South Sudan.
- Draw up reports and presentation documents
- Representation of the project together with the line manager in close cooperation with all relevant actors active in the field and the region.
- Maintain close cooperation with all team members.
- Regular travel is required.

- Knowledge of local government structures in South Sudan and Gender related national and international legislations.

- Very good knowledge of English, and Arabic, knowledge of German is an added value.
- Excellent people skills and ability to negotiate between different stakeholder groups.
