Brief back ground

Episcopal Development Aid (EDA) is a registered, fully-fledged faith-based non-profit, non-political, non-governmental, multi-sectoral relief and development aid organization dedicated to breaking the cycle of poverty and to enhance communities' livelihoods by delivering a sustainable solution to the various groups of vulnerable people within the community.

Job purpose: Registered midwife will take day-to-day tasks and duties of reproductive health activities at the assigned health facility under the line management of the head of the health facility the midwife will ensure quality care of reproductive health in facility to all the clients. This position demands excellent knowledge of reproductive, neonatal health care, strong ability, desire and competence to cooperate with and participate in continued medical education led by clinical officer to continue the capacity building. Coordination between the reproductive health and EPI departments within the clinic's will need to be strengthened to ensure that all ANC mothers TT immunizations as per their vaccination status and that all new born are vaccinated against polio and tuberculosis before leaving the health facilities.

Key Responsibilities

Uphold EDA values; positively and actively contribute to the team's wellbeing and spiritual life.

Key Duties

- ❖ Support the clinic set up



- ❖ Ensure all pregnant mothers receive focused Antenatal care.
- ❖ Ensure all pregnant and lactating women receive nutrition education
- ❖ Conduct clinic deliveries and ensure that all the deliveries are done at the facility.
- ❖ Provide postnatal care services to the mother and the new born
- ❖ Provide family planning (FP)/child spacing services and ensure that services meet MOH and international guidelines.
- ❖ Ensure infection control in reproductive health units by sweeping dump dusting, washing and disinfecting, decontaminating, sterilizing and correct use of gloves at all the time before and after handling the clients.
- ❖ Ensure timely referral of all the cases in the reproductive and neonatal health care.
- ❖ Ensure that the daily activities in the reproductive and neonatal health clinics start with health and nutrition education targeting barriers to safe clinic deliveries, exclusive breastfeeding/good nutrition, hygiene, benefits of postnatal care, family planning, cord card etc.
- ❖ Collect and report reproductive and neonatal health data to the head of health facility.
- ❖ Ensure that all mothers attending ANC & PNC mothers receive mosquito nets, soap during the visit as per the EDA distribution guidelines
- ❖ Ensure that all ANC & PNC mothers receive the right prophylaxis deworming and supplementation of various micronutrients as per MoH guidelines to ensure optimal health for both mother fetus and newborns.

Qualifications

- Diploma of midwife regulatory board/body registered with good standing
- Qualified Registered midwife with knowledge of performing BEmONC seven signals functions.
- At least 5-6 years of experience as registered midwife
- Had an experience in rendering reproductive neonatal health care services in health facility settings.
- Previous experience in reproductive health care programmes with international organizations/agencies is an added advantage
- South Sudanese nationality
- Staff management experience and good interpersonal skills.
- Fluent in spoken and written English
- Nuer language is desirable
- Knowledge of MS office application is an advantage
- Good written and oral communication skills
- Enthusiastic and keen to work hard to achieve the program objectives.
