Introduction

Reporting Lines:

The County Health Coordinator shall report directly to Project Coordinator.

Purpose of the position

The County health coordinator will be responsible for coordinating primary health care service delivery and will be focal person for Health System Transformation Project in the County. Coordinate all health activities in the county which includes technical support to County Health department and rationalisation of human resource in the supported Health facilities.



Key accountabilities and Responsibilities

- Administratively manage Health System Transformation project activities in Abiemnom County on behave of Cordaid.
- Organise and conduct with CHD joint routine supportive supervision and monitoring the implementation of HSTP in the supported health facilities and Bomas with BHWs.
- In collaboration with CHD, organize and implement training and refresher trainings for the health workers based on identified training needs and according to work plan and harmonized training guidelines.
- In collaboration with CHD, provide technical support in the implementation of all primary health care
 activities at all level of health facilities including; epidermiological surveillance, safe motherhood
 services, OPD care, EPI, BHI activities and quality of care interventions.
- In collaboration with CHD, organize and promote raising awareness and sensitization campaign on health promotion and access/utilization primary health care services.
- Develop and share field visit reports, training reports and activity progress reports, participate in writing monthly, quarterly and yearly reports with Project coordinator and Area coordinator.
- In collaboration with CHD, provide continuous capacity building, monitoring and supervision of health service delivery, ensuring the quality management of patients and delivering of care according to MOH guidelines.
- Maintain high, cordial and professional working relationship with County health department and other actors in the County.
- Support other projects related to health in Abiemnom County including the TB/HIV project and coordinate with other projects.
- Track, approve and review field purchase requests and ensure monthly forecast and financial reporting.
- Organise and attend relevant coordination meetings (weekly and monthly) at the County level and give feedback to Project Coordinator and UNICEF as may be necessary.
- Promote project visibility (this will include MOH, UNICEF, World Bank and Cordaid) in projectbased events.
- Ensure donor compliance at every stage in the implementation of the project. This includes compliance in the areas of financial expenditures, procurements, use of equipment et
- Manage all security, logistics, and procurement issues of the project in liaison with Juba office.
- Represent Cordaid at County level events/functions.
- Attend to other duties as instructed and directed by the line Manager.

Qualifications and skills

- 1. A Bachelors in Public Health or any other related field with clinical background is much preferred.
- 2. At least 3 years in primary health care service delivery supervision.
- 3. Ability to develop implementation plans for project activities.
- 4. Strong work ethic, reliability and Attention to details.
- 5. A good understanding and experience of working with County health department Officials, Donars, UN agencies in South Sudan.
- 6. Excellent report writing and reporting skills and people skills.
- 7. Ability to work under pressure to deliver and in a resource limited area.
- 8. Ability to work independently or as part of the team with minimum supervision.
- 9. Must have good networking skills.
